ORDER VACATING TRIAL AND SCHEDULING ORDER AND SETTING STATUS CONFERENCE

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on Defendant Idaho Water Resource Board's ("IWRB") Third Motion to Amend Scheduling Order, filed through counsel on December 15, 2023. On January 2, 2024, Plaintiff Strider Construction Co. Inc. ("Strider") objected.

IWRB requests that the current scheduling order (filed November 29, 2023) and jury trial currently set to begin on June 17, 2024, be vacated for public safety reasons as the Priest Lake Dam's infrastructure is unstable and must be stabilized before its experts can complete certain necessary testing. Completion of these tasks depends on the temperature, which is currently too cold to perform the necessary work. The Court finds good cause exists to vacate the trial and current scheduling order.

Therefore, the trial and third scheduling order are VACATED. A status conference is scheduled for February 21, 2024, at 4 p.m.

At the status conference, IWRB is directed to provide timelines and deadlines for the completion of the infrastructure work and expert testing.
