I, Maximilian C. Bricker, declare the following:

1. I am an attorney representing Petitioner City of Pocatello in the above-captioned matter.
2. Pursuant to this Court's August 17, 2023 *Procedural Order*, the oral argument in this matter has been set for January 11, 2023, at 1:30 pm.
3. On October 26, 2023, Petitioners filed an *Unopposed Motion to Modify Procedural Order Briefing Schedule*.
4. On October 30, 2023, Petitioners filed a *First Amended Unopposed Motion to Modify Procedural Order Briefing Schedule*, asking the Court to vacate the briefing schedule until Petitioners' *Motion to Augment the Record* was decided.
5. On October 31, 2023, the Court granted the foregoing motion and vacated the briefing schedule.
6. On November 9, 2023, the Court heard the parties' arguments on the *Motion to Augment the Record*, and granted the motion from the bench. The Court also instructed the parties to confer regarding a new briefing and oral argument schedule.

7. The parties have conferred and stipulated via email to the proposed briefing schedule and new date for oral argument that is contained in the *Unopposed Motion to Set Briefing Schedule and Extend Time for Oral Argument* (“Motion”), filed herewith, which is displayed below:

8. As explained above, this is the third request for a modification of the briefing schedule. The Court previously vacated the briefing schedule and has not yet set a new schedule.
