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#### RE: 2021 Incurred Losses for the Decree 37-0472/Rodney F and Kaysi S Hubsmith

We are looking at a projected shut-off date of June 15, 2021. Here are our projected damages if the projection holds true. **Devastating!** With the short fall of Big Wood Canal Co. (Magic Reservoir) we have become dependent on our 37- water decree on our lands. With no other water available because of our geographical location on the upper reach of the Little Wood River near Richfield, ID.

### For the 2021 crop year:

- One cutting of timothy grass hay on 40 acres, most years there are two cuttings. On full water years I have a 5-ton average per acre. With this year's water shut-off, we will get an average of 2 1/2 ton per acre. Average grass hay at \$180.00 per ton, will equal a \$450 short fall per acre, which is a total of \$18,000 for 40 acres.
- During a full water year, there will be lush fall irrigated grazing into November. This pasture will sustain approximately 40 pairs of cattle. With a projected shut-off of June 15, 2021, pasture on the lands under 37 Decree, will only last until the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2021. Looking at it from a by-pair per month, renting pasture rate of \$35.00 which is a \$175.00 loss per pair (5 months loss) for this 2021 season, this is a \$7000.00 loss.
- Now looking at the 20 acres of irrigated pasture, that will only sustain 20 head, with the same formula as above; 20 pairs at a rate of \$175 loss per head, that equals another \$3500.00 loss.
- The above figures did not include pounds of beef lost, by early dispersal. We are looking at about \$300 per calf lost on 60 head, that figures in to be another \$18,000.

\$18,000 — Timothy Grass Hay \$7000 — Pasture loss for 40 pair \$3500. — Pasture loss for 20 pair \$18,000 — Pounds of beef loss

The total of loss resulting from the projected shut-off 37 decree on June 15, 2021.

In conclusion based on this year's water predictions, including both Big Wood Canal Co, and Decree 37, the cattle operation will be liquidating at least half of the built-up herd of 140 head of stock cows. Which makes the entire operation unprofitable for 2021. The operation will be in rebuild mode for the future years, which also needs to be totaled into this year's Losses.
