DECLARATION OF LACEY B. RAMMELL-O'BRIEN

- I, Lacey B. Rammell-O'Brien, certify and declare under penalty of perjury pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, that the following is true and correct:
- 1. I am over the age of eighteen (18) years and competent to testify to the matters contained herein. I make this declaration pursuant to Idaho Code § 9-1406 and based on my own personal knowledge.
- 2. I am currently a deputy attorney general for the Office of the Attorney General representing the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR). My work address is 322 E. Front Street, Boise, ID 83702-7371. I have served in this capacity since June 2021.

Dear Water User,

The Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") has issued the enclosed Final Order ("Order") requiring installation of controlling works and measuring devices on certain surface and ground water diversions in Administrative Basin 74. The Order requires non-irrigation diversions be controlled and measured by January 1, 2019, and irrigation diversions by the start of the 2019 irrigation season.

The Order waives the measurement requirement for diversions authorized to irrigate less than or equal to five (5) acres and non-irrigation uses authorized to divert less than or equal to 0.24 cubic feet per second. Shared diversions with multiple water rights are subject to the requirements of the Order if the sum of the acres authorized by water rights exceeds five (5), or the sum of diversion rates authorized for non-irrigation water rights exceeds 0.24 cubic feet per second.

Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701A(3), any person aggrieved by the Order may, within fifteen (15) days after receipt of written notice of the Order or receipt of actual notice, file with the Director of the Department a written petition stating the grounds for contesting the Order and requesting a hearing.

Enclosed is the Department's *Minimum Acceptable Standards and Requirements for Open Channel and Closed Conduit Measuring Devices*. BACKGROUND

On April 6, 2006, the Director ("Director") of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") issued a final order creating Water District No. 170 ("WD170") to include specific surface water and ground water rights in Administrative Basins 71 and 72. The Director stated he would "issue separate orders, as necessary, requiring the installation of measuring devices and lockable controlling works for diversions within Water District No. 170." On February 20, 2007, the Department issued an order requiring installation of measuring devices and controlling works for diversions of surface water and ground water in Administrative Basins 71 and 72.²

On December 10, 2012, the Department issued an order expanding WD170 to include specific surface water and ground water rights in Administrative Basin 73.³ On March 3, 2014, the Department issued an order requiring installation of measuring devices for diversions of ground water rights within Water District No. 73.⁴

On April 10, 2018, the Department issued an order expanding WD170 to include specific surface water and ground water rights in Administrative Basin 74 ("Basin 74").⁵ This order designated existing water districts within Basin 74 as sub-districts of WD170, modified sub-districts to include ground water diversions, and combined certain sub-districts within Basin 74. The April 10, 2018, order excluded domestic and stockwater rights as defined by Idaho Code §§ 42-111 and 42-1401A(11), and rights for in-stream watering of livestock as defined by Idaho Code § 42-113.

LEGAL PROVISIONS

Section 42-701, Idaho Code, states, in pertinent part:

42-701. INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CONTROLLING WORKS AND MEASURING DEVICES BY WATER APPROPRIATORS – PROCEDURE UPON FAILURE TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN – MEASURING AND REPORTING OF DIVERSIONS – PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY – REPORT FILING FEE.

- (1) The appropriators or users of any public waters of the state of Idaho shall maintain to the satisfaction of the director of the department of water resources suitable headgates and controlling works at the point where the water is diverted. Each device shall be of such construction that it can be locked and kept closed by the watermaster or other officer in charge, and shall also be of such construction as to regulate the flow of water at the diversion point. Each such appropriator shall construct and maintain, when required by the director of the department of water resources, a rating flume or other measuring device at such point as is most practical in such canal, ditch, wellhead or pipeline for the purpose of assisting the watermaster or department in determining the amount of water that may be diverted into said canal, ditch, wellhead or pipeline from the stream, well or other source of public water. . . .
- (2) [T]he appropriator may, upon approval of the director, execute an agreement with the director and submit to the director such information and technical data concerning the diversion and pumping facilities as the director determines necessary to establish the relationship of power usage to water withdrawal by any pump used to divert public water.
- (3) Any appropriator or user of the public waters of the state of Idaho that neglects or refuses to construct or maintain such headgates, controlling works, or measuring devices, or has not executed an agreement in lieu of a measuring device as provided in subsection (2) of this section, upon receiving ten (10) days' notice from the director of the department of water resources within which to begin and diligently pursue to completion the construction or installation of the required device or devices or to begin and diligently pursue to completion a remedy to such defects as exist in accordance with said notice, then the director of the department of water resources may order the duly qualified and acting watermaster of the water district to shut off and refuse to deliver at the point of diversion, the water owned by such appropriator or user until the user does construct and maintain such headgates, controlling works or measuring devices or remedy the defects which exist or the director may take action pursuant to section 42-1701B, Idaho Code, to enforce the requirement to construct, install or maintain such devices.
- (4) The appropriators or users of the public waters of the state of Idaho shall be given a reasonable time within which to complete construction of such headgates, controlling works or measuring devices, depending upon the size and extent thereof, when due diligence has been used in the prosecution of such work.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Idaho Code § 42-701(1) authorizes the Director to require installation and maintenance of suitable, lockable headgates and controlling works, and measuring devices at the point where the water is diverted.
- 2. The Director has a "clear legal duty to distribute water" according to the partial decrees issued by the Snake River Basin Adjudication ("SRBA") District Court. *City of Blackfoot v. Spackman*, 162 Idaho 302, 309 (2017). The SRBA District Court issued the *Final Unified Decree* on August 26, 2014. *Final Unified Decree*, In re SRBA, Case No. 39576 (Fifth Jud. Dist. Ct. Aug. 26, 2014).
- 3. The control and measurement of diversions in Basin 74 is necessary for the Director to comply with his "clear legal duty to distribute water" according to decreed water rights. Adequate control and measurement of diversions ensures:
 - a. The regulation of diversions within the water district or sub-district is consistent with the legal requirements of the prior appropriation doctrine, thereby protecting senior priority rights during times of water scarcity;
 - b. The diversion of water associated with a decreed water right does not exceed the legal limits of the decree; and
 - c. The assessments of individual water users within the water district are calculated based on the amount of water delivered, consistent with Idaho Code §§ 42-612(3) and 42-615.
- 4. The Director should require the installation of suitable, lockable headgates and controlling works and measuring devices within Basin 74.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This order applies to all surface and ground water rights within Basin 74, except domestic and stockwater rights or uses defined by Idaho Code §§ 42-111 and 42-1401A(11), and rights or uses for in-stream watering of livestock as defined by Idaho Code § 42-113.
- 2. The owners of all affected surface and ground water rights within Basin 74 shall install and maintain on each point of diversion lockable headgates and controlling works.
- 3. The owners of all affected surface and ground water rights within Basin 74, except those water rights, uses and diversions identified in item 4 below, shall install and maintain on each point of diversion a measuring device of a type acceptable to the Department.

 Owners of non-irrigation rights shall comply with this order by January 1, 2019, and owners of irrigation rights shall comply with this order by the start of the 2019 irrigation season.

- 4. The installation of measuring devices required by this order is waived until further notification by the Department for the following water uses and diversions:
 - a. Surface or ground water diversions authorized to irrigate less than or equal to five acres⁶; and
 - b. Surface or ground water diversions for any purpose other than irrigation authorized to divert less than or equal to 0.24 cfs (approximately 108 gallons per minute).⁷
- 5. Measuring devices acceptable to the Department are devices identified in the Department's *Minimum Acceptable Standards and Requirements for Open Channel and Closed Conduit Measuring Devices* ("Minimum Acceptable Standards," enclosed).
- 6. Controlling works and measuring devices must be properly maintained, repaired or replaced if determined inaccurate or inoperable by the Department, the WD170 watermaster or the presiding sub-district watermaster.
- 7. The Department will consider a request for variance from the requirement to install measuring devices listed in the Minimum Acceptable Standards upon submittal of a written request to the watermaster of WD170. Acceptable variances are limited to the following methods or devices:
 - a. Use of an hour meter (time clock) for open discharge wells with electric pumps that operate at a constant rate of flow; or
 - b. Use of an acceptable closed conduit flow meter installed prior to the date of this order; or
 - c. Use of power consumption coefficient for irrigation wells with a single operating condition and an electric pump connected to a dedicated demand meter; or
 - d. Rated sections or non-standard devices in open channels with approved measurement plans satisfying the requirements of the Minimum Acceptable Standards.
- 8. All requests for variance must be received by the WD170 watermaster by **December 1**, **2018**. The watermaster and the Department will consider requests on a case-by-case basis. Variance requests proposing use of an existing flow meter will be denied unless the existing meter is tested and satisfies the Department's established standards for accuracy and the manufacturer installation specifications. Existing meters that do not satisfy the established standard for accuracy and the manufacturer specifications must be replaced with a meter from the Department's *List of Approved Closed Conduit Flow Meters* (most

- 9. If a user cannot comply with the deadlines in item 3 of this order, the Department may grant an extension. An extension request for each diversion must be submitted to the WD170 watermaster by **December 1, 2018**. Extension requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Conditions that may result in the Department granting an extension include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. The diversion is unused; or
 - b. Unique site specific condition(s) prevent accurate water measurement; or
 - c. Delays caused by requirements of other government entities.
- 10. This order shall become effective immediately for any new diversion(s) authorized after the date of this order, except water right diversions described in item 4 of this order.
- 11. If a water user fails to comply with the requirements of this order, the Director may issue an order instructing the WD170 watermaster and presiding Basin 74 sub-district watermaster to shut off and refuse delivery of water at any non-compliant diversion.
- 12. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701A(3), any person aggrieved by this order may, within fifteen (15) days after receipt of written notice of the order or receipt of actual notice, file with the Director a written petition stating the grounds for contesting the order and requesting a hearing.

STATE OF IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES (IDWR)

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR OPEN CHANNEL AND CLOSED CONDUIT MEASURING DEVICES

The water source, diversion structure and conveyance system must be adequately evaluated prior to selection of a measuring device. Surface water sources such as streams, springs and drains are commonly diverted into open channels, ditches or canals. Closed conduits such as pipes or culverts are also used to convey surface water. Ground water is more commonly diverted into pipes (closed conduits) which convey water from the well to system discharge points such as irrigation sprinkler systems. Ground water may also discharge from a well through a short section of pipe to open channels, ditches or ponds. When required by IDWR, measuring devices must be installed at or very near the point of diversion to ensure the watermaster can accurately determine the amount of water diverted from the public water source. The standards below are intended to qualify measuring devices that are "acceptable to the Department", and to assist water users and watermasters in the proper selection and installation of such devices when required pursuant to Section 42-701, Idaho Code.

I. MEASUREMENT IN OPEN CHANNELS

The following requirements are applicable to diversions from surface water sources. Measurement of a ground water diversion with an open channel measuring device must be specifically approved by IDWR.

A. Industry Standard Open Channel Measuring Devices

All open channel surface water diversions must be measured using one of the following industry standard (standard) open channel flow measuring devices:

- Weirs: contracted or suppressed rectangular weirs, Cipolletti weir, 90 degree V-notch weir
- **Submerged Orifices:** submerged rectangular orifice, constant head orifice
- **Flumes:** Parshall flume, trapezoidal flume, ramped flume (ramped, broad-crested weir)
- Current Meter/Acoustic Profiler: acoustic Doppler flow meter (ADFM), acoustic Doppler current profiler

Construction, installation and operation of these devices must be consistent with water measurement guidelines, published by the United States Bureau of Reclamation¹ or the United Stated Geological Survey². Measuring devices, associated rating tables and specifications contained in these publications are considered by IDWR to be industry standard.

B. Non-Standard Open Channel Devices Including Rated Structures or Rated Sections

Any weir, flume or other measuring device that has not been constructed, installed or maintained to measure flow consistent with industry standard rating tables or curves shall be considered non-standard. IDWR may authorize the use of non-standard devices or rated channel sections on a case by case basis, upon the submittal and approval of a measurement plan. A measurement plan must contain an acceptable proposal, using industry standard procedures for developing a rating curve, or document that a rating curve has been fully developed for the device or section. Proposed rating plans must include provisions for periodic re-measurement and maintenance of the rating. The established rating must achieve the desired accuracy standard of plus or minus ten percent ($\pm 10\%$), the equivalent accuracy of a standard open channel device. All rating measurements must be conducted by a qualified individual (eg. engineer, hydrologist, certified examiner), using a standard portable open channel measuring device. If a measurement plan is not approved by IDWR, a standard device must be installed and maintained.

II. CLOSED CONDUIT MEASURING DEVICES

The following requirements are applicable to measurement of diversions from any water source that conveys water through a full pipe or conduit. Full pipe means that water within the pipe is under at least some positive pressure and contains insignificant amounts of air or gas.

A. Standard Closed Conduit Measuring Devices

Standard closed conduit measuring devices are flow meters that have been approved for use by IDWR based on independent third party testing. IDWR has developed and published a list of meters that have been tested and approved for use³. Tests were conducted for both accuracy and repeatability on all submitted models. The lab tested accuracy standard for flow rate is plus or minus two percent (± 2%). The *IDWR List of Approved Closed Conduit Flow Meters* (approved list) may be found at: https://idwr.idaho.gov/files/water-measurement/approved-flow-meter-list.pdf

Approved full profile magnetic flow meters and spooled ultrasonic flow meters must be installed with a minimum straight pipe length equivalent of three (3) pipe diameters upstream and two (2) pipe diameters downstream measured from the center of the meter spool. Approved clamp-on and wetted ultrasonic flow meter transducers must be located with a minimum straight pipe equivalent of ten (10) pipe diameters upstream and five (5) pipe diameters downstream of the nearest transducer. All other manufacturer installation specifications (excepting up and down spacing) must be met. *Installation of an approved meter inconsistent with the requirements noted above, may be cause for IDWR to require reinstallation of the meter*.

B. Requests for Variance to Use Power Consumption, Hour Meter or Existing Meter

Requests for variance will be considered for qualifying diversions on a case by case basis only upon submittal of the appropriate "Request for Variance" form. If a water user can demonstrate that an existing flow meter or other method of measurement meets an equal standard of accuracy when compared to meters on the approved list, a variance may be granted. If a variance request is not granted, an approved meter will be required.

The following alternate measurement methods may be considered:

- Development of a Power Consumption Coefficient (PCC), which is a ratio of power usage to water withdrawal,
- Use of an hour meter (time clock), or
- Use of a flow meter that was *installed prior* to the date a measurement order was issued and *is not* on the IDWR approved list.

Any alternate measurement method will require field testing using a portable ultrasonic flow meter or other meter tested and accepted by IDWR (testing meter). Field testing may be performed by any of the following:

- IDWR staff,
- a water district watermaster,
- a ground water district hydrographer,
- an irrigation district hydrographer,
- a certified field examiner, or
- as otherwise approved by IDWR

Existing flow meters must be operational and installed consistent with applicable specifications. If the testing margin of error of an installed meter when compared to the testing meter exceeds plus or minus ten percent $(\pm 10\%)$ for mechanical type meters, or plus or minus five percent $(\pm 5\%)$ for magnetic or ultrasonic type meters, the installed meter must be replaced with a new meter from the approved list. The owner or operator of any diversion system which requires a field measurement must provide a testing section of unobstructed straight pipe 15 pipe diameters in length.

Notice of Requirement to Install Controlling Works and Measuring Devices – West and East Springs,

Water Right No. 74-157

Water Users:

On September 28, 2018 the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR or Department) issued a *Fincl Order* in the Matter of Requiring Controlling Works and Measuring Devices on Surface and Ground Water Diversions (Measurement Order) for the entire Lemhi River Basin, including tributary streams. The deadline for compliance with the Measurement Order was prior to the 2019 irrigation season for all irrigation diversions.

On June 10, 2020 I met with Jordan Whittaker and the WD74Z watermaster Merritt Udy at the West Spring, which is one of two spring sources for irrigation water right 74-157. The West Spring flows into Lee Creek and is rediverted from Lee Creek into a ditch. Two weirs have been installed in Lee Creek, one above and one below the spring inflow, which enable a measurement of the West Spring. An orifice plate is installed at the head of the spring rediversion ditch which Mr. Whittaker estimated would limit the total flow entering the ditch to 80 inches, or 1.6 cfs. Based on area of the orifice opening and the upstream head over the opening, I calculated a free-flow discharge through the orifice of approximately 93.5 inches (1.87 cfs).

The flumes in the creek are acceptable for measuring the total spring discharge. An orifice plate of standard dimensions could be used to quantify the rediverted spring flow from Lee Creek, but the ditch lacks a sufficient control structure or headgate. Whittaker indicated that the East spring had no control structure or measuring device. Both springs are tributaries to Lee Creek under right 74-157, and required to be administered in priority with Lee Creek water rights. The watermaster must have adequate control of the diversions, including the ability to close the ditches and allow the spring flows to return to Lee Creek when the right is not in priority.

Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-701 and the Lemhi Basin Measurement Order, you are hereby required to install and maintain suitable and lockable controlling works, and standard measuring devices on both the East and West springs within 30 days of the date of this letter.

RE: Cease and Desist Unauthorized Diversion of Stroud Creek (aka Left Fork of Lee Creek) Waters (E2022-2813)

Dear Mr. Whittaker:

The Department has been working with Merritt Udy, watermaster for Water District 74Z (WD74Z), to ensure Stroud Creek water can be delivered to downstream senior water right holders on Lee Creek. Currently, Whittaker Two Dot Land, LLC (Whittaker) captures and diverts all water in the Stroud Creek drainage below Whittaker's authorized Stroud Creek diversion (Ericsson corral) at or before the West Springs Ditch. The West Springs Ditch cuts across the Stroud Creek drainage within the NENE, Sec 31, Twp 16N, Rge 25E, B.M. (map attached). Water right 74-157, owned by James and Paula Whittaker, authorizes only the diversion of 3.2 cfs from springs tributary to Lee Creek. The complete capture of water by the West Springs Ditch deprives downstream senior water rights on Lee Creek from receiving their rightful entitlement of water. Whittaker has no authorized diversion point(s) for Stroud Creek water below the Ericsson corral diversion. Based on IDWR records, communication with the WD74Z watermaster, and direct communication with Jordan Whittaker, the Department concludes that Whittaker's diversion of Stroud Creek water as noted above is not authorized. Downstream of the Ericsson corral diversion, Whittaker is only entitled to divert spring water when water right 74-157 is deliverable by priority.

As identified in the attached map, the natural drainage of Stroud Creek runs through Whittaker's property (outlined 120 acres). By diverting Stroud Creek water at the West Springs Ditch, refusing to allow Stroud Creek to flow downstream of the West Springs Ditch through the natural drainage, and diverting tributary springs out of priority, Whittaker may be subject to 1) administrative and civil enforcement actions for violating the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-351; and 2) a private civil action from downstream water user(s).

On September 28, 2018, the Department issued an order requiring installation of measuring devices and controlling works on water diversions in the Lemhi River Basin. These devices were required to be installed prior to the 2019 irrigation season. In a letter from the Water District 170 watermaster dated June 23, 2020, James and Jordan Whittaker were again notified of this requirement and the applicability to diversions under water right 74-157. Diversions in WD74Z must be equipped with suitable headgates, controlling works, and measuring devices pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-701. The suitability of such controlling works and measuring devices shall be determined by the watermaster and the Department. Currently, there are two headgates associated with Whittaker's authorized Stroud Creek diversion near the

Ericsson corral. The in-channel headgate on Stroud Creek is not suitable because it limits the amount of natural flow that can pass down the Stroud Creek drainage depending on gate position. The newer headgate on the Whittaker ditch appears suitable for proper administration of water rights 74-369, 74-1136, and 74-15788, by the watermaster.

The Department requires that Whittaker immediately implement and accomplish the following actions:

- 1. Cease diverting the waters of Stroud Creek below the authorized diversion point for water rights 74-369, 74-1136, and 74-15788, near the Ericsson corral. The Department's field observations confirm that the Stroud Creek channel exists above and below the Whittaker in-channel headgate.
- 2. Remove or modify the in-channel headgate noted in no.1 above to allow all Stroud Creek water in excess of authorized diversions under water rights 74-369, 74-1136, and 74-15788, to flow downstream to the confluence with Lee Creek. An open-top check structure in Stroud Creek, designed to direct water through the new headgate on the existing ditch may be determined suitable.
- 3. Install suitable headgates or controlling works and measuring devices at or near both diversion points authorized by water right 74-157. The WD74Z watermaster must have the ability to deliver spring waters, tributary to Lee Creek, downstream to satisfy senior water rights.

Failure to comply with the above requirements on or before May 5, 2022, may cause the Department to initiate enforcement action(s) under Idaho Code § 42-1701B, and to seek injunctive relief in the district court for violation of the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-351.



Re: Delivery of McConnell Water Rights

Dear Director Spackman:

I represent Bruce and Glenda McConnell ("McConnell"), senior right holders on Lee Creek, in Lemhi County, Idaho. The McConnell water rights are: 74-361, 74-362, 74-363, 74-364, 74-365, 74-367, and 74-368.

As you are aware, on November 2, 2021, you issued an *Order on Exceptions; Final Order Approving Transfer* ("Final Order") in which you adopted Hearing Officer James Cefalo's *Preliminary Order Approving Transfer, Order Denying Petitions for Reconsideration* and *Order Denying Petition to Re-Open Hearing and Petition for Site Visit*, approving the addition of McConnell's historic point of diversion on Lee Creek. In so doing, you explicitly found no injury would result to the upstream water rights held by James Whittaker and Whittaker Two Dot Ranch ("Whittaker") that are tributary to Lee Creek. Another notable finding from the Final Order was the fact that Whittaker's capture of Stroud Creek water at the West Springs Ditch is unauthorized and therefore illegal. *Preliminary Order* at 5, ¶ 24.

On January 14, 2022, I sent a letter to the watermaster asking for priority delivery of McConnell's Lee Creek water rights. The list of water rights in the January 14, 2022 letter was corrected by a letter I sent on January 25, 2022. Attached are copies of the letters for your convenience.

On April 6, 2022, David Graybill, with the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("IDWR"), Salmon Field Office, performed a Field Investigation of the Whittaker diversions upstream of McConnell, finding, among other things, that recent earth work is allowing West Springs Ditch to capture Stroud Creek water to the detriment of Lee Creek: "Recent earth work that results in the capture of Stroud Cr. and West springs water. This location is where [watermaster] Merritt Udy was able to deliver West springs water to Bruce McConnell. Due to the recent blockage all water collected in the west springs ditch including Stroud Cr. water get[s] diverted to the east side of a hill and can not reach Lee Cr." Emphasis added. Attached is a copy of the Field Investigation for your convenience.

On April 21, 2022, IDWR sent a letter to Whittaker to "Cease and Desist Unauthorized Diversion of Stroud Creek (aka Left Fork of Lee Creek Waters)," in which IDWR notified Whittaker to stop his illegal diversion of water at West Springs Ditch. Emphasis added. IDWR warned Whittaker: "Failure to comply with the above requirements on or before May 5, 2022, may cause the Department to initiate enforcement action(s) under Idaho Code § 42-1701B, and to seek injunctive relief in the district court for violation of the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-351." Attached is a copy of this letter for your convenience.

With water not being delivered to them, my clients reached out to Mr. Graybill as to the status of the enforcement. On June 10, 2022, my clients received an email from Mr. Graybill informing them IDWR had changed its mind to enforce against Whittaker due to threat of litigation:

We decided <u>not</u> to put water in the ditch because we received an email from Whittakers (sic) attorney putting in writing that all Stroud Creek water that is released below Ericssons (sic) Corral would go into Whittakers (sic) private ditches.

Emphasis added. Attached is a copy of the email for your convenience. The issue of water in Whittaker's private ditch was raised below and rejected by you and Hearing Officer Cefalo. *See also Martiny v. Wells*, 91 Idaho 215, 216-17, 419 P.2d 470, 471-72 (1966). No stay of your Final Order was asked for by Whittaker, IDAPA 37.01.01.780, nor was a stay issued *sua sponte*.

As you are aware, IDWR has a clear legal duty to deliver water, in priority. I.C. § 42-602; *Musser v. Higginson*, 125 Idaho 392, 395, 871 P.2d 809, 812 ("We conclude that the Director's duty to distribute water pursuant to this statute is a clear legal duty. The director himself testified that he was aware that his duty to deliver water under I.C. § 42-602 is mandatory."). Whittaker's water rights are junior to McConnell and tributary to Lee Creek; therefore, the Director has a clear legal duty to rectify Whittaker's illegal diversion and deliver water to McConnell.

While the spring and early summer was unusually wet in the Lemhi drainage, flows in Lee Creek have dropped. With diminishing flows comes the paramount, Constitutional responsibility to deliver water rights to senior users ahead of junior users. Idaho Const. Art. XV § 3. By way of this letter, my clients again demand delivery of their Lee Creek water rights, water that Whittaker is preventing from flowing downstream. Because time is of the essence, my clients request that IDWR take action no later July 8, 2022, to restore the flow of water to them. If IDWR does not take steps to restore the flow of water by July 8, 2022, my clients have instructed me to take all steps necessary to ensure their water is made available to them for irrigation this year.

On January 14, 2022, I sent a letter to both of you on behalf of Bruce and Glenda McConnell, asking for priority delivery of the McConnell irrigation water rights as to junior water rights in the Lee Creek drainage, including but not limited to the junior water rights identified in James Cefalo's *Preliminary Order* approving Transfer No. 84441 in the name of Bruce and Glenda McConnell (May 18, 2021), as affirmed by Director Gary Spackman in his *Order on Exceptions; Final Order Approving Transfer* (November 2, 2021).

In the January 14, 2022 letter, I listed the McConnell water rights as: 74-361, 74-362, 74-363, 74-364, 74-367, and 74-368. I was recently made aware that this list of water rights inadvertently omitted water right no. 74-365. The omission of water right no. 74-365 was unintentional. Water right no. 74-365 should be included in the list of McConnell water rights for priority delivery.

Please consider this letter as a correction to the January 14, 2022 letter.

Field Investigation - Narrative



April 2022, Department staff and WD74Z watermaster conducted a field investigation at the Two Dot Ranch located in T16NR25E Sections 30, and 31 in Lemhi County. The goal of the field investigation was to understand if and how the Stroud Cr drainage had been altered to prevent Stroud Cr and West Springs water from connecting with Lee Cr and to check the compliance status of measurement and control requirements. The field investigation started at Whittaker's "upper diversion" located near the Ericsson corral and progressed down the Stroud Cr drainage ending at the confluence with Lee Cr. The investigation findings are as follows. Stroud Cr is clearly identified above the Ericsson Corral (Picture 1) at which point two headgates are located (Picture 2). The east headgate controls water flowing into a ditch system, "the ditch headgate", while the west headgate controls water flowing into the Stroud Cr channel, the "in-stream headgate". The in-stream top-down headgate prevents excess water in the system from flowing down Stroud Cr and must be removed, or if needed for control, it can be replaced with a bottom-up control design.

Immediately downstream of the ditch headgate is the ditch heading north and the ditch weir (Picture 4). The ditch weir and headgate meet Department standards. The ditch heads north to the "ditch split" (Picture 5) where water can flow east to commingle with the east springs water and then to the pivot or it can continue north and commingle with the west springs water and head to a different pivot. Immediately downstream of the in-stream headgate is the Stroud Cr Channel (Picture 3) heading NE towards the "west springs area" (see map). The West Springs Area is comprised of nearly flat topography, willows, thick vegetation, and marsh like conditions and the hydrology is dynamic including both subsurface and surface flow, water likely channelizes during periods of high flow. The Stroud Cr drainage through the west springs area is likely in similar condition and function as it was before land development up to the "west springs ditch" (Picture 6). The west springs ditch traverses nearly the entire Stroud Cr drainage collecting and diverting water from both Stroud Cr and the west springs before heading east to the POU. This diversion does not have any control or measurement, control at this diversion is critical for the priority delivery of Stroud Cr and west springs water. Adequate control of the diversion will be difficult as the west springs ditch acts as a 0.25-mile-wide diversion and simply placing a headgate in the ditch likely will not result in adequate control of the diversion.

In 2021 Department staff instructed the 74Z watermaster to deliver west springs water in priority to a water user down stream on Lee Cr. By placing a metal plate in front of an 18" cipolletti weir (Picture 7) located in Whittaker's ditch the watermaster was able to deliver the water west in a return flow ditch back into the Stroud Cr drainage. During the site visit department staff observed recent earth work (Picture 7) that resulted in a complete block of the return flow ditch eliminating any path for the diverted water to be returned to the Stroud Cr drainage. As department staff continued to work down the drainage from the west springs ditch they observed that there was not any water flowing down the drainage past the ditch. However, 425 ft down gradient of the west springs ditch water was observed to be subbing up and flowing and gaining water as it moved down the drainage and by 625 feet past the west springs ditch, Stroud Cr had re-channelized and was flowing at a rate of near 1 cfs (Picture 8) and continued to gain flow all the way to the confluence with Lee Creek.

Hi Glenda,

We decided not to put water in the ditch because we received an email from Whittakers attorney putting in writing that all Stroud Creek water that is released below Ericssons Corral would go into Whittakers private ditches. Also, we would be giving the Whittakers 7 cfs in their ditches which they would likely use to irrigate their fields with their pivots. Currently Merritt has been instructed to deliver all water on Stroud and Everson that is deliverable in priority. Yes, this results in Whittaker being delivered water while we work on a resolution. Though I will say the Whittakers are certainly not getting the extra 7 cfs that they would have been getting if we performed the test and tried to deliver the water to you. There is currently no way under Idaho Law for us to deliver the Stroud water to you. We are though diligently working on a resolution in this matter. Also, it seems to me that the offer the Whittakers made with you is good and if it were me I would exploring that option. You would likely get most of your water, of which you have not seen in a long time.
