Re: Cat Creek Energy Applications for Permit Nos. 63-34403, 63-34652, 63-34897, and 63-34900 FERC update

Dear parties:

As you are aware, in September of last year the Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") granted an order staying the proceedings on Cat Creek Energy, LLC ("CCE") applications for permits for CCE's proposed pump storage project in Elmore County, Idaho (the "Project"). The stay was granted because studies and determinations made during the Project's Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") and the Bureau of Reclamation ("BOR") proceedings are likely to address and resolve issues considered by the Department under Idaho Code § 42-203A(5). In an effort to keep protesters and interested parties appraised of FERC and BOR developments, a January 11, 2023 letter was sent to the parties, discussing CCE's proposed study plan filings and meetings/comment periods impacting said study plan. This letter and is being sent to update everyone further this matter.

CCE completed its initial coordination with a number of county, state, and federal agencies, along with non-governmental organizations, and submitted to FERC on January 25, 2023, a draft proposed study plan for the Project, which is available on the FERC website. The study plan outlines the proposed studies CCE may conduct to assess possible effects of the Project on water quality, fish and wildlife, cultural, recreation, aesthetic, land use and tribal resources. Interested parties and agencies will continue to work together to finalize the proposed study plan, and will conduct a meeting on February 22nd and 23rd, 2023, to accomplish this goal. The meeting will address how the scope of the proposed study plan interplays with FERC's rational nexus test and the BOR requirements for CCE's Preliminary Lease of Power Privilege. The meeting can be attended virtually, or in person at the USBR Snake River office conference room (230 W. Collins Road, Rm. #104, Boise, Idaho 83702). After the February meeting a 30-day open comment period on the proposed study plan will open with FERC, where protesters and the public can contribute their thoughts and suggestions. In addition to those county, state, and federal agencies have already contributed during the meeting stage. After the comment period closes, said comments will be filed with FERC on April 26, 2023, and a revised study plan will be filed by CCE on May 26, 2023. After the revised study plan is filed another comment period will open, with comments to be filed with FERC by June 10, 2023.

As this process continues CCE shall continue to update the interested parties on any further relevant dates or updates.
