THIS. AGREEMENT, made this 20th day of September, 1993 (the "Agreement"), by and between the STATE OF IDAHO ("Idaho"), by and through the IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES ("IDWR"), an agency of the State of Idaho; the IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF FISH & GAME ("IDF&G"), an agency of the State of Idaho; the IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION ("IDP&R"), an agency of the State of Idaho; the IDAHO POWER COMPANY ("IPC"), a corporation, organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and RIM VIEW TROUT COMPANY, INC. ("Rim View"), a corporation, organized and existing pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, at times hereinafter collectively referred to as the "parties";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, IPC, Rim View, and IDF&G each claim the right to the use of the waters of certain springs, commonly referred to as Niagara Springs, located in Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 15 East, B.M., Gooding, Co. Idaho, based upon certain licenses, permits, and beneficial use claims; and

WHEREAS, while Rim View, IPC and the Idaho Water Resource Board ("IWRB") have applications pending before the IDWR seeking the issuance of permits to allow the waters of Niagara Springs to be placed to additional beneficial uses, as of the date of this Agreement, IPC, Rim View, IDP&R and IDF&G are the only persons or entities placing the waters of Niagara Springs to beneficial use; and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of November, 1987, the District Court of the Fifth Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Twin Falls, entered a Commencement Order initiating the Snake River Basin Adjudication ("SRBA"), more specifically entitled: The State of Idaho, ex rel. R. Keith Higginson in his official capacity as director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources, Petitioner, v. United States; State of Idaho; and all claimants to the use of water from the Snake River Basin Water System, and designated as Civil Case # 39576; and

WHEREAS, the Commencement Order, in describing the boundaries of the "Snake River Water System," included in said description the lands upon which Niagara Springs is located, said springs being located in Reporting Area 3, and further required that all claimants asserting rights to the use of water from the Snake River Basin Water System, pursuant to license or historic or beneficial use, file a claim to such use with the IDWR; and

WHEREAS, consistent with that Order, IPC, Rim View and IDF&G each filed SRBA claims to water rights with the IDWR for their respective use of the waters of Niagara Springs, those claims being consistent with the water rights identified in $\P 1(a-b)$, 2(a-c), and 3(a-b), above; and

WHEREAS, on the 2nd day of November, 1992, the Director of the IDWR, filed a Director's Report for Reporting Area 3 with the Court, that report containing, pursuant to I.C. § 42-1411, the Director's recommendation of the rights to the use of the waters NIAGARA SPRINGS AGREEMENT, Page 3 of 20

of Niagara Springs, true and correct copies of the Director's recommendations as to each of the claims of IPC, Rim View and IDF&G to the waters of Niagara Springs being attached hereto as Exhibit A, and by said reference made a part hereof; and

Section 10

WHEREAS, the Director's recommendations differ from the claims to water rights filed by IPC, Rim View and IDF&G; and

WHEREAS, IPC, Rim View, and IDF&G, pursuant to I.C. § 42-1412, filed objections to the Director's recommendation of their own, and each others, claims to the use of water from Niagara Springs; and

WHEREAS, the spring flow from Niagara Springs is , at times, insufficient to satisfy the claims of IPC, Rim View and IDF&G; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to allocate the flows of Niagara Springs, IPC and Rim View entered into an Agreement, dated July 31, 1981, along with amendments thereto, providing for the distribution and use of the waters from Niagara Springs; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the further decline in the flows of Niagara Springs, Rim View, on November 18, 1992, filed Consolidated Alternative Motions for Writ of Mandamus, Preliminary or Permanent Injunctions and Interim Administration and Request for Expedited Hearing in the SRBA, naming the IDF&G and IDWR as Defendants, and asking the Court to (i) permit the formation of a water district in the area of Niagara Springs and the appointment of a water master, (ii) modify the Reporting Area 2 Director's Report by deleting that portion of the IDF&G claim relating to the use of the waters of Niagara Springs for wildlife

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use, in the quantity of 11 cfs, for the period January 1 to December 31 of each year, and (iii) adjust the headgate serving the IDF&G claim until the flow of Niagara Springs Creek, at Rim View's point of diversion, increases to 210.3 cfs, or more; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 1992, after conducting an evidentiary hearing, the Court entered an Order Granting Preliminary Injunction in Part, Granting Mandamus, and Setting Hearing on Permanent Injunction and set the hearing on the permanent injunction for January 26, 1993; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to stipulation of the parties to that litigation (Rim View, IDF&G, and IDWR), and the representation that the parties to that controversy desired to discuss and attempt to resolve the issues surrounding the use and allocation of the waters of Niagara Springs, the Court vacated the January 26, 1993, hearing, set an interim diversion rate for IDF&G's use of the waters of Niagara Springs and set the matter for status conference in April, 1993, for the purposes of reporting on the progress of the settlement discussions; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the Court's entry of the order vacating the hearing and setting the status conference, the parties to this Agreement entered into discussions intended to resolve all issues relating to the use and allocation of the waters of Niagara Springs, including issues relating to the claims to water rights filed in the SRBA and the applications pending before the IDWR for the appropriation and use of such waters, it being the intent and desire of the parties, by the execution of this Agreement, to dispense with the necessity of

further litigation in the SRBA or further administrative proceedings before the IDWR with regard to the use and allocation of the waters of Niagara Springs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants and conditions herein contained and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, agree as follows:

1. THE SRBA.

- (a) The respective subcases relating to each objection and the related water right, of the parties to the waters of Niagara Springs may be decreed by the Court in the manner set forth on Exhibit B, as attached hereto and by said reference made a part hereof, below, and that said decree shall further provide, that as between the parties to this Agreement, and their successors and assigns, the allocation and use of the waters of Niagara Springs, so long as this Agreement shall remain in effect, shall be governed by the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- (b) If objections are filed by persons or entities that are not parties to this Agreement (third party objections), the Parties shall cooperate in attempting to resolve those objections, through negotiation or litigation, in a manner consistent with the terms of this Agreement. If, however, third party objections, or any other aspect of the SRBA, render performance of the water allocation provisions of this Agreement impossible, this Agreement shall be null and void and of no further force and effect.
 - 2. Allocation of the Waters of Niagara Springs.

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- (a) Exhibit B, together with existing permits and applications for permit referred to on Page 2, reflect the relative priorities of the water rights of the parties to the use of the waters of Niagara Springs. Despite such priorities, the parties agree that allocation of the waters of Niagara Springs, and consequently Niagara Springs Creek, shall be governed by this Agreement so long as this Agreement is in full force and effect.
- (b) Fulfillment or satisfaction of the collective water rights reflected on Exhibit B requires spring flows from Niagara Springs in excess of 230 cfs. The spring flows from Niagara Springs in recent years have been substantially below that amount. To facilitate the optimum beneficial use of the waters of Niagara Springs at such times as the spring flows are not sufficient to satisfy the collective water rights set forth on Exhibit B, the flows of Niagara Springs, subject to the proration provisions of ¶ 3, shall be allocated as follows:
 - (i) IPC shall be entitled to divert from Niagara Springs Creek, on a monthly basis, for fish propagation, domestic use, irrigation and fire protection, the following:

(d) Subject to the availability of water and the proration provisions of paragraph 3, the following minimum monthly flow rate in Niagara Springs Creek below the discharge at the IPC hatchery shall be maintained:

This minimum flow in Niagara Springs Creek consists of the following: 1) water coming over the "lower falls" [2(c) above], 2) seepage below the falls, which for the purposes of this Agreement is, regarding the measurement of any right referenced herein, assumed to be a constant 5 cfs, and 3) IPC hatchery discharge water.

(e) The parties acknowledge that the location of the various diversions/uses referred to in \P 2(b) & (d) above at times require the reuse of previously diverted water to fill or satisfy such diversions/uses. This results in some diversions/uses being filled with water diverted from Niagara

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Springs Creek for the first time, "fresh water," and other diversions/uses being filled by water discharged after another's use, "used water." The diversions/uses required to use used water to fulfill portions of their right are the Rim View diversion for fish propagation, \P 2(b)(ii), and the minimum stream flow use below the IPC hatchery discharge, ¶ 2(d). latter use is comprised of (i) fresh water from over the "lower falls," (ii) fresh seepage water below the falls, agreed to be 5 cfs, and (iii) used water discharged from the IPC hatchery. former use, Rim View's, is comprised of a fresh water diversion above the lower falls and, as required to fulfill the right, used water discharged from the IPC hatchery. During certain times of the year when the spring flows are sufficient and IPC's use is reduced, all of Rim View's right, as agreed to in ¶ 2(b)(ii), can be satisfied through the diversion of fresh water at the Rim View diversion above the lower falls. However, during the months that IPC's use is increased, or should the spring flows decline, a portion of Rim View's right must be filled by used water discharged from the IPC hatchery.

(f) To the extent that the flows of Niagara Springs are in excess of the Base Flows, as defined in ¶ 3(a), and sufficient to satisfy all of the diversions/uses referred to in this ¶ 2, any excess flows over and above the Base Flow may be diverted/used by parties in conformity with the rights and priorities listed on Exhibit B or as subsequently decreed by the Court in the SRBA, provided that the water can be put to a beneficial use as recognized by the laws of the State of Idaho. Notwithstanding

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the provisions in \P 2(a), flows above the "Base Flows" as defined in \P 3(a) shall be allocated pursuant to the prior appropriation doctrine.

3. Allocation of Reduced Spring Flows.

(a) Because the flow of Niagara Springs is dynamic, and subject to fluctuation and the possibility of decline, at times the flow of Niagara Springs may not be sufficient to satisfy all existing diversions/uses of Niagara Springs as represented by ¶ As illustrated on Exhibit C, attached hereto, the minimum "Base Flow," required fulfill spring flow, to or all diversions/uses agreed to in ¶ 2, fluctuates from a high of 230 cfs during the months of May to September, to a low of 217 cfs during November through February, these figures representing the diversions/uses of fresh water from Niagara Springs, for a given time period, including a seepage loss below the lower falls of 5 Consistent with Exhibit C, the parties agree, for the purposes of this Agreement, that the "Base Flow," shall be as follows:

(b) Any reduction in the flows of Niagara Springs below the agreed upon Base Flow for a given period shall result in a corresponding reduction in the following diversions/uses:

(i) IPC's diversion of fresh water for fish propagation, domestic use, irrigation, and fire protection;

Exhibit D sets forth the software spread sheet formula for the pro ration of the water among the water rights in this Agreement. The formula in Exhibit C shall govern the distribution of water under this Agreement, and Exhibit D is included only for illustrative purposes.
 - Pending Applications for Permits.
- (a) The parties shall withdraw any pending protests to application #'s 36-08347 & 08670 (IWRB), for minimum instream flows, and 36-07791 (Rim View), for fish propagation, provided:
 - (i) the applications are not modified or amended;
 - (ii) any permits issued recognize that the decreed rights as set forth on Exhibit B are senior to and have priority over the right(s) granted by the permit; and
 - (iii) the minimum stream flows for Niagara Springs Creek when at or below the base flows are governed by the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- (b) Rim View intends to seek to perfect its application no. 36-07628. The IPC and the State of Idaho agree not to protest the application to the extent that Rim View seeks to increase its

SOLUMED Jim 25 2002 fresh water use by an amount not to exceed 20 cfs. The parties other than Rim View and IDWR shall have the option of joining as applicants in application no. 36-7628, by written notice to Rim View served no later than April 1, 1994. Any parties who become applicants shall share in proportion to their rights established by license or by beneficial use as stated in paragraphs 1 through 4, above.

- (c) All other applications filed by the parties and pending before the IDWR shall be withdrawn.
- (d) For purposes of this processing applications for permits, this Agreement does not affect the Director of IDWR's authority under Chapters 2 and 15 of Title 42 of the Idaho Code.
 - 5. Measuring Devices.
- (a) As a permanent resolution of the controversy regarding installation of a measuring device closer to Rim View's diversion works on Niagara Springs Creek, Rim View shall install a measuring device, with the capability of recording flow information, at a point in the canal or flume above the access road to the IPC steelhead hatchery, as close as feasible to the Rim View headgates on Niagara Springs Creek. That measuring device will be constructed in conformance with the plans already submitted by Rim View to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and to IDWR, unless changes are requested by Rim View and approved by FERC and by IDWR. The measuring device shall be installed on or before November 13, 1996, as part of the construction of the hydropower facility authorized as FERC Project No. 9543-004, but if Rim View surrenders its current FERC

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exemption or that exemption expires, then within one year after such surrender or expiration. Exhibit E is a copy of the exemption for FERC Project No. 9543-004.

- (b) Until a new measuring device is installed by Rim View as provided in paragraph 5(a), Rim View's diversions from Niagara Springs Creek shall be measured at Rim View's existing discharge weirs.
- (c) The State, through one of its administrative departments, shall install measuring devices at the lower falls and at the nearest feasible point on the IDF&G diversion at the upper reach of the springs before December 31, 1994.
- (d) If the watermaster or the IDWR representative is required to devote significantly more time to measurement of any water user's water from Niagara Springs Creek than is devoted to measurement of the next most time consuming of the other water rights in Niagara Springs Creek, then the water user whose water right requires significantly more time for measurement shall pay a reasonable rate to the watermaster or to IDWR for the extra time required to perform measurements and to adjust the headgate or headgates.
- (e) All measuring devices installed pursuant to this ¶, and the measuring devices existing at the time of execution of this Agreement at the IPC hatchery, shall be calibrated on an annual basis and properly maintained to ensure accuracy. Each party responsible for such calibration and maintenance shall keep records of such activities and, upon written request by any other Party to this Agreement, make such records available for review.

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Cross check gages shall be installed at appropriate locations at the IPC hatchery diversion and the Rim View flume to facilitate the visual monitoring of flows. The measuring devices referred to in this ¶, when properly maintained and calibrated, constitute the best evidence of the flows diverted at the location of the respective devices.

Water Quality at Rim View's Discharge. 6.

A material term of this Agreement is Rim View's receiving (1) approval and issuance of a permit under Application No. 36-07791 with no conditions imposed except those consistent in all respects with this Agreement and (2) water quality certification and an NPDES permit no more restrictive than Rim View's present The purpose of this term is to ensure that Rim View will be able to reuse IPC water as if it were fresh water. Rim View agrees to use due diligence in obtaining such certification if required. If Application No. 36-07791 is denied or issued with conditions that prevent Rim View from substituting Idaho Power used water for fresh water to obtain a total flow of 150 cfs, or if Rim View receives a final decision from a state agency or a federal agency having jurisdiction of the matter, denying such certification, or a final decision of a state court or a federal court upholding the applicable agency's denial of such certification, Rim View shall have the option to declare this Agreement null and void, by written notice to the other parties to this Agreement. If Rim View declares this Agreement null and void, any or all of the parties to this Agreement shall have the right to commence an appropriate action in the SRBA

Court, or in any other court having jurisdiction of the matter, to obtain modification of any interim decree, or the final decree, in the SRBA, for the purpose of obtaining relief from whatever adverse impacts might result to that party as a result of this Agreement being declared null and void.

This Agreement shall not preclude Rim View from asserting that concessions it has made in this Agreement mitigate any effects on water quality that might be caused by increased production in Rim View's facilities through the use of Rim View's discharge water under Permit No. 36-7789. None of the other parties by executing this Agreement shall be deemed to agree with this assertion.

Those provisions regarding the installation of measuring devices in this Agreement shall remain effective even if this Agreement is declared void.

- 7. Niagara Springs Creek Estuary Cleanup.
- (a) IPC and IDF&G shall cooperate in initiating and completing a study to determine the most effective and economical method(s) available for the removal of the accumulated sediment and other pollutants, if any, from the portion of Niagara Springs Creek lying between the base of the lower falls and the outlet of the estuary into which the IPC hatchery discharges water.
- (b) Upon completion of the above study, and subject to its findings and any applicable provision of existing state and federal law, including the Clean Water Act and Endangered Species Act, IPC will undertake the efforts necessary to remove the accumulated sediment and other pollutants, if any, from the

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referenced area. IDF&G agrees to allow IPC to place materials removed from the estuary on IDF&G property provided IPC complies with all applicable federal and state laws and the materials are not deemed a hazardous waste or substance under state or federal law.

8. Forfeiture, Abandonment and Adverse Possession.

Nothing herein shall constitute or evidence an intent to abandon any of the vested water rights identified on Exhibit B, nor form the basis for an action for forfeiture or adverse possession with regard to any such rights. To the extent that this Agreement contemplates or allows a party or parties to use flows of Niagara Springs that may be subject to a senior priority, such use is permissive and subject to the terms of this Agreement. A party's use of the flows of Niagara Springs, in a manner inconsistent with the provisions of this Agreement, and the corresponding failure of a party to object to such use and initiate action to enforce the Agreement's provisions, shall not constitute a waiver of such a party's rights under this Agreement, nor bar a party from initiating action to enforce the provisions of the Agreement, regardless of diversion/use in a manner inconsistent with such provisions.

9. Waiver, Modification or Amendment.

No waiver, modification or amendment of this Agreement or any covenants, conditions, or limitations herein contained shall be valid unless in writing and duly executed by all the parties.

Attorneys Fees and Costs.

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Each party shall bear their own attorneys fees and costs for litigating this matter, including but not limited to Rim View's consolidated alternative motions and any subsequent proceedings, and in any subsequent litigation to enforce this Agreement.

11. Claims of Rim View Against IPC and the State.

This Agreement does not resolve or affect the claims Rim View has asserted against IPC and the State as a result of the incident referred to in the Notice of Tort Claim, dated ---, submitted by Rim View to the State of Idaho, and all parties to this Agreement retain and reserve all claims, causes of action, or defenses they may have as against all other parties to this Agreement, or third persons, resulting from said incident.

12. Successors and Assigns.

This Agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the respective successors and assigns of the parties.

13. Governing Law.

This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Idaho.

14. Effect on Prior Agreements

This Agreement is supplemental to the prior written agreements between IPC and Rim View relative to the distribution and use of the waters of Niagara Springs and the provisions of those prior agreements, to the extent not inconsistent with this Agreement, shall survive its execution.

15. Evidence of Negotiations

This Agreement has been reached in the process of good faith negotiations for the purpose of resolving legal disputes, NIAGARA SPRINGS AGREEMENT, Page 17 of 20



including pending litigation, and all parties agree that no offers and/or compromises made in the course thereof shall be construed as admissions against interest or be used in any legal proceeding.

16. Entry of Judgment

Entry of judgment as set forth above has been consented to by the parties without trial or adjudication of fact or law herein and without the judgment constituting evidence or an admission by any party, with respect to any issue.

17. Merger Clause.

This Agreement sets forth all the covenants, promises, provisions, agreements, conditions, and understandings between the parties, and there are no covenants, provisions, promises, agreements, conditions, or understandings, either oral or written, between them other than as are set forth herein.

18. Effect of Section Headings.

The section headings appearing in this Agreement are not to be construed as interpretations of the text, but are inserted for convenience and reference only.

19. Interim Distribution

Among IPC, Rim View and IDF&G this Agreement shall serve as the basis for distribution of water of Niagara Springs and Niagara Springs Creek pending action by the District Court on this Agreement.

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20. Quintuplicate Originals.

This Agreement is executed in quintuplicate. Each of the five Agreements with an original signature of each party shall be an original.

2. Relationships To Calculate Allocations of Reduced Flows.

The allocation of base flows (BF) are shown on page 3 of this exhibit. The symbols defined above are shown, where applicable, on the allocation table on page 3.

All flows of Niagara Springs less than base flows are allocated by the following relationships. Included with each relationship is an example computation for March with a current flow (CF) of 190 cfs.
