

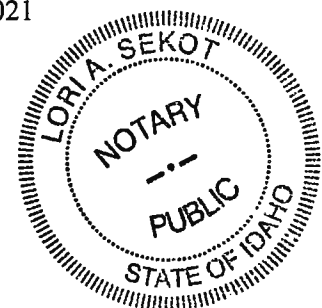

**NOTICE OF PETITION FILED BY  
MILNER IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
REGARDING STORAGE SET IN  
WATER DISTRICT 01 ANTIATION  
OF FORMAL PROCEEDINGS**

Notice is hereby given that on August 18, 2017, Milner Irrigation District ("Milner") submitted a letter to the Department of Water Resources ("Department") asserting that the "storage reset" for purposes of water administration in Water District 01 is not authorized in the current water right partial decree for the Lake Walcott storage right and "has in effect curtailed the natural flow water right 1-17 (1916 priority date) in violation of the law." The Director requests that the Water District ensure Milner receives appropriate natural flow as required by law.

Milner's letter is a petition to the Department's Rule 37.01.01.230. See IDAPA 37.01.01.230. The letter is available at the following site for this matter: <http://www.idaho.gov/legal-actions/petitions/actions/milner-petition>

The Director will continue to address the petition in accordance with the Department's Rule of Procedure 37.01.01.104). A hearing procedure may be requested at the Department or at the following link: <https://admin.idaho.gov/current/37/0101.pdf>

The Director will hold a public hearing on November 13, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. (MDT) at the Department Office, located at 320 North 6th Floor, Director's Office, Boise, Idaho 83720. Persons seeking to intervene in the hearing should file a petition for intervention at the prehearing conference or by telephone at the prehearing conference will be held in accordance with provisions of Chapter 42 and Chapter 43 of the Idaho Code, and the Department's Rule of Procedure.

Milner is a party to this matter. Any person who wants to formally participate in the proceedings should file a petition for intervention with the Department by November 13, 2017, in accordance with the Department's Rule of Procedure 350-352. See IDAPA 37.01.01.350-352.
