Notice is hereby given that, on August 18, 2017, Milner Irrigation District ("Milner") submitted a letter to the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") asserting the "fall storage 'reset' for purposes of water right administration" in Wa-ter District 01 "is not authorized in the current storage water right partial decrees, including the Lake Walcott storage right (1-219)" and "has in effect curtailed Milner's natural flow water right 1-17 (November 14, 1916 priority date) in recent years." Milner requests "the Water District and District rector ensure Milner receives the appropriate natural flow as required by Idaho law.
