



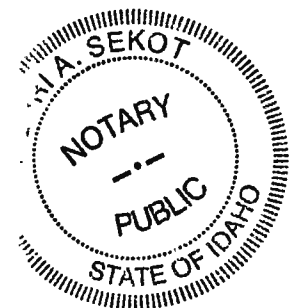

**NOTICE OF PETITION FILED BY
MILNER IRRIGATION DISTRICT
REGARDING STORAGE RIGHTS IN
WATER DISTRICT 01 AND INITIATION
OF FORMAL PROCEEDINGS**

Notice is hereby given that, on October 10, 2017, Milner Irrigation District submitted a letter to the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department") asserting that the Department's "age 'reset' for purposes of 'administration' in Water District 01 is not authorized in the current water right partial decrees. Lake Walcott storage right "has in effect curtailed Milner's flow water right 1-17 (No. 1916 priority date) in record. Milner requests "the Water Director ensure Milner receive appropriate natural flow as provided by law."

Milner's letter is a petition under the Department's Rule 37.01.230. See IDAPA 37.01.230. The petition is available at the Department's website for this matter at <http://www.idwr.gov/legal-actions/administrative-actions/milner-petition>.

Parties and those seeking to intervene in the prehearing conference will be represented at the prehearing conference in person or by telephone. The prehearing conference will be held in accordance with provisions of the Department's Rules of Procedure 2 and 17, Title 42 and Chapter 67, Idaho Code, and the Department's Rules of Procedure.

Milner is a party to this matter. **Parties who want to formally participate in the prehearing conference must file petitions to intervene with the Department by November 13, 2017 in accordance with the Department's Rules of Procedure 350-352. See IDAPA 37.01.01.350-352.**
