BACKGROUND

On April 26, 2021, the Idaho Department of Water Resources (“Department”) issued an *Amended Interlocutory Order Regarding Instructions to Water District 34 Watermaster; Notice of Status Conference* (“Amended Order and Notice”) in the above-captioned matter. The Amended Order and Notice included notification of a status conference to be held in this matter on January 19, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. (MST). 
