We did not receive your letter indicating that it is necessary to notify you that we intend to remain a party in the above matter. However as the letters from attornies began arriving we wondered what was going on, but since there were no letters from individuals we assumed it was another case of legal posturing and pulp mill and USPS profits as the stack of letters grew daily.
