RE: Notice of Order Revising July 2021 Forecast Supply and Amendment to Ground Water Rights Curtailment List—Surface Water Coalition Delivery Call

Dear Water Right Holder,

You are receiving this letter because, according to the records of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (“Department”), you are the holder of one or more ground water rights that were subject to the Department’s *Final Order Curtailing Ground Water Rights Junior to June 14, 1977* (“Second Curtailment Order”), issued August 4, 2021.

On August 23, 2021, the Department issued the *Order Revising 2021 Forecast Supply (Methodology Steps 7-8)* (“August Forecast Supply Order”), which accompanies this letter. The Step 7 revised demand shortfall (DS) prediction was smaller than the previous July Forecast Supply Order DS, and, therefore, the Department was required to adjust the curtailment priority date cutoff.

The new curtailment date is January 21, 1979. Because January 21, 1979, is junior to the July Forecast Supply Order curtailment date of June 24, 1977, previously curtailed ground water rights owned by you, but senior to January 21, 1979, are no longer subject to the Second Curtailment Order. Attachment A to the August Forecast Supply Order sets forth the specific ground water right holders and numbers ***no longer*** subject to curtailment.
