EXTENSIONS OF TIME

Considering the decision of the Fifth District Court in the case of Bishop vs. Higginson, the following is our policy regarding reinstatement and extensions of time.

Idaho 42-218 and 42-218a should be considered together in determining if an extension of time should be granted upon request of reinstatement as described in 42-218a.

If within sixty days of being sent a lapse notice an applicant requests a renstatement, we will, upon showing of reasonable cause, reinstate the permit. The
applicant may also be granted an extension of time upon reinstatement. Receipt of
a request for an extension of time may also be considered as a request for reinstatement. If the request does not show reasonable cause, the applicant should be
so notified and requested to provide the information needed. Upon receipt of the
additional information, a reinstatement and extension of time can be granted. In
determining the number of days to advance the date of priority, the date of receipt
of the original request should be used.
