I will try and address your questions. You are welcome to comment on any of the edits that have been made to the rules and recommend any changes you would like to see made. This year's process is specific to rule 61.01 and 61.03 including any logical outgrowth that occurs. For example, we have added some additional definitions and edited the definition for OHWM. In five years IDWR is scheduled to enter rulemaking for the remainder of the IDAPA 37.03.07 rules. I think your second question is related to whether you are part of the 15 dredgers for this year. That questions needs to be asked to DEQ, but I believe you are part of the 15.
