Water rights 02-00201, 02-00223 and 02-00224 are limited to a combined minimum flow rate of 5,600 CFS average daily flow from November 1 to March 31 as measured at the "Murphy Gaging Station" described below.

OTHER PROVISIONS NECESSARY FOR DEFINITION OR ADMINISTRATION OF THIS WATER RIGHT:

1. The "Murphy Gaging Station" is located at T01S, R01W, S35, NWSE, Boise Meridian, on the right bank approximately 4.2 miles downstream from Swan Falls Power Plant.
2. This water right shall not be administered or enforced against any water rights diverting from the waters of the Snake River or surface or ground water tributary to the Snake River upstream from the Milner Dam gaging station, (River Mile 638.7).

THIS PARTIAL DECREE IS SUBJECT TO SUCH GENERAL PROVISIONS NECESSARY FOR THE DEFINITION OF THE RIGHTS OR FOR THE EFFICIENT ADMINISTRATION OF THE WATER RIGHTS AS MAY BE ULTIMATELY DETERMINED BY THE COURT AT A POINT IN TIME NO LATER THAN THE ENTRY OF A FINAL UNIFIED DECREE. I.C. SECTION 42-1412(6).
