

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AFFECTING MORE THAN \$25 MILLION

This is notice that **the Idaho Water Resource Board** intends to enter into an agreement to obligate by contract, agreement, or otherwise the State of Idaho in the amount of more than \$25 million or intends to enter into an agreement concerning a transaction in which goods, services, real estate, or other property reasonably valued at more than \$25 million is acquired, sold, or included in a part of the agreement.

Specifically, you are notified that a decision may be made on or after 30 days from the date this notice is sent and **will concern six miles of canal within the Boise Project Board of Control (Boise Project) located in southwestern Idaho and a portion of eastern Oregon. The office of the Boise Project is located at 2465 Overland Rd. Boise, Id 83705. The purpose of this \$50 million transaction is to rehabilitate and improve six miles of canal lining. The project includes replacement of approximately six miles of the existing concrete and asphalt lining with a prefabricated multi-layer geocomposite membrane and concrete cap, over a six-year period.**

This transaction is not being made pursuant to the request for proposals process in Idaho Code, and the transaction has not been specifically approved by the Idaho Legislature.
