

Idaho Water Resource Board approves 10 flood grants statewide, creates new Groundwater-to-Surface Water grant program

SODA SPRINGS – (July 29, 2024) – The Idaho Water Resource Board approved 10 flood management grants statewide at a cost of approximately \$702,300 on Friday during its bimonthly meeting here in Southeast Idaho.

The Board also approved the creation of a new Groundwater-to-Surface Water conversion grant program with a budget of \$20 million. The first round of applications will be due in October 2024.

The new grant program will encourage water users to reduce groundwater withdrawals in areas where groundwater aquifers are in decline, particularly the Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer, or areas in the state where a Critical Groundwater Management Area or Groundwater Management Area have been designated. More information will be forthcoming about the new grant program in August.
