

# Downloading Well Construction reports

## Well Construction:

1. Navigate to <https://idwr.idaho.gov/wells/find-a-well.html>.
2. Read the splash screen that appears and click 'OK.'
3. Click on the blue triangle pull-down located at the top left of the map (between the IDWR logo and the prompt to "Enter Well #").
4. Select "Critical Ground Water Areas" and type "Raft River" in the search bar where it reads "Enter Name of CGWA" and hit ENTER. This will zoom to the Raft River CGWA.
5. Click on the "Layers" button at the bottom of the map. It is a blue circle with white squares that look like a stack of paper.
  - a. A popup box will appear with all of the layers that can be displayed on the map.
6. Select/de-select as many layers as you want to see. Make sure "Wells" is selected.
7. Click on the "..." to the right of "wells" in the Layers popup box.
8. Click on "Set visibility range."
9. Pull the slider to the left until it reads "County."
10. Close the "Layers" popup box.
11. Click on a well.
  - a. A popup box will appear with summary information.
12. Click on the "More info" hyperlink if you want to see the driller's report.
  - a. You will be redirected to the "Well Construction & Drilling" page on the IDWR website.
13. The link to the driller's report is a hyperlink at the bottom of the page.
  - a. The hyperlink is the well owner's name.
14. You can download the report using your browser
