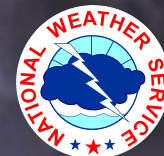
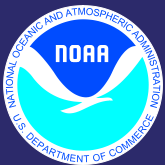


Sea Surface Temperatures are Near Normal

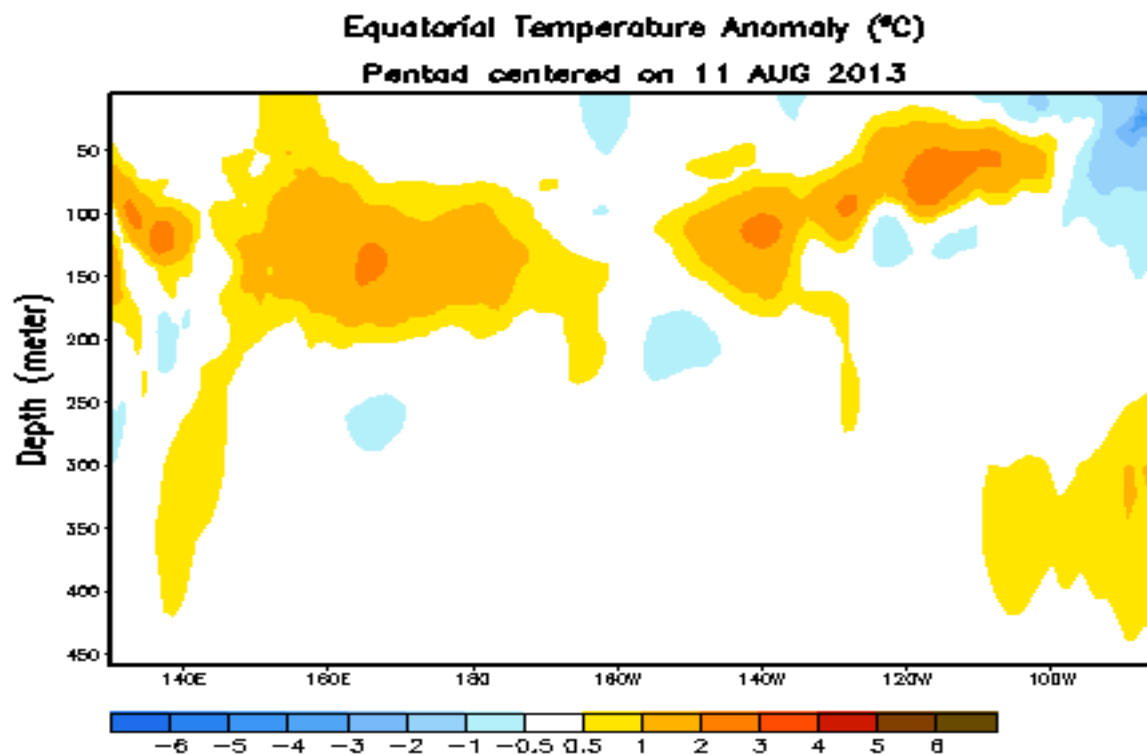


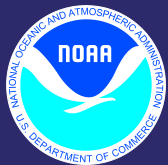
Week centered on 24 JUL 2013
SST Anomalies (°C)



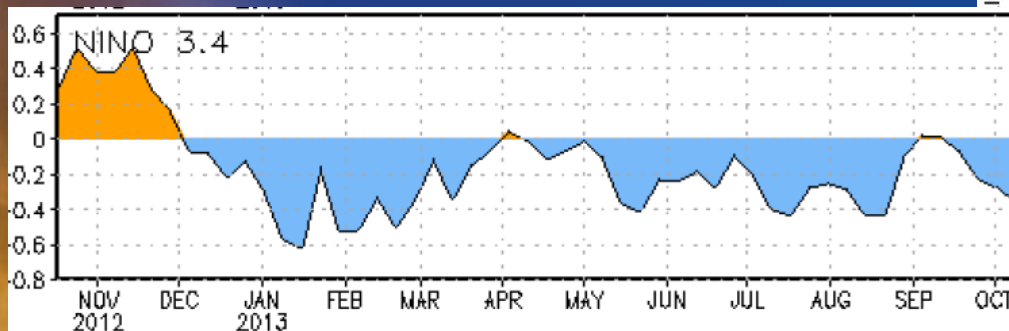
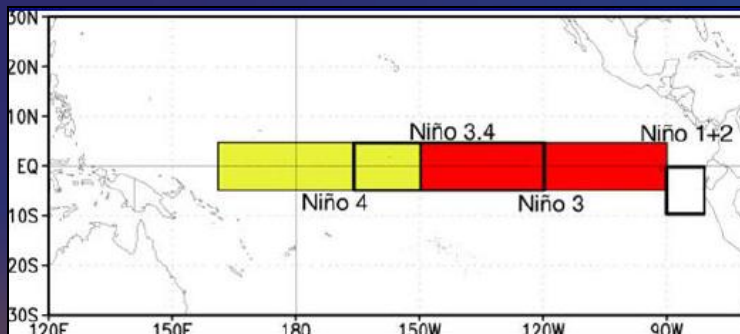
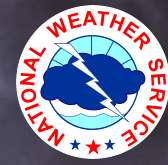


Pacific Ocean Temperatures below the surface

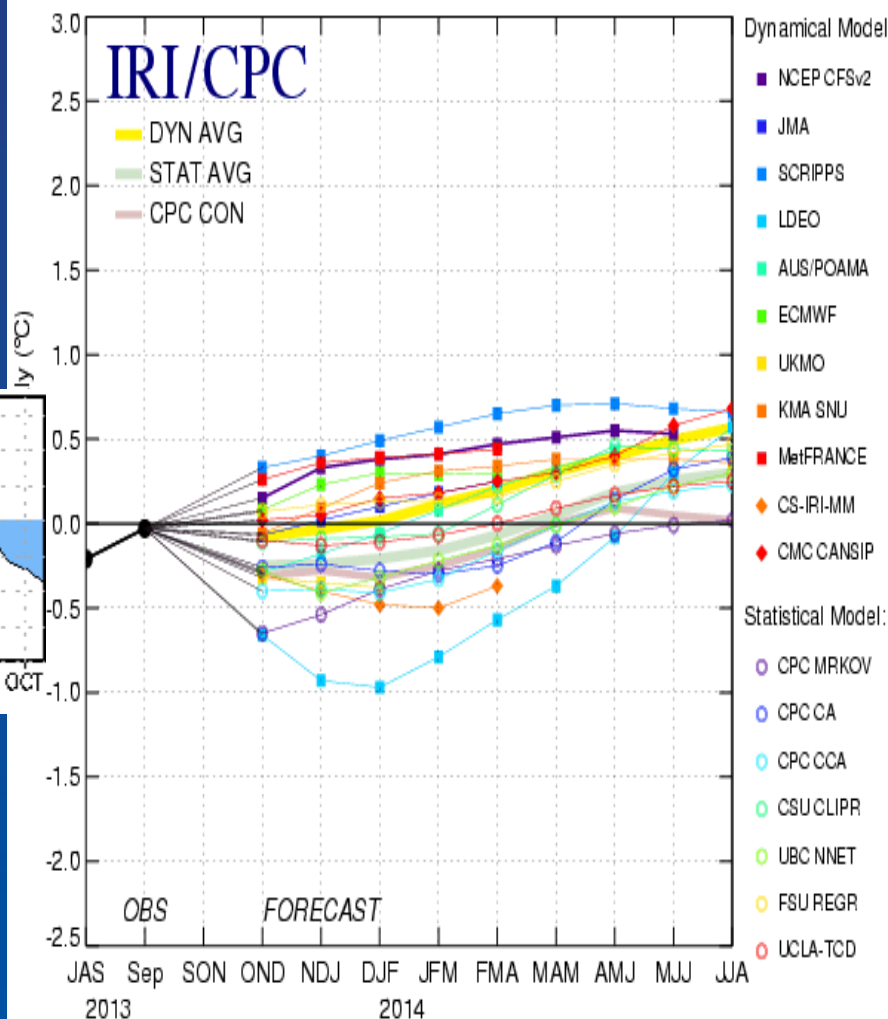


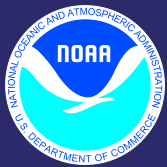


Most Models Keep SST near normal through winter

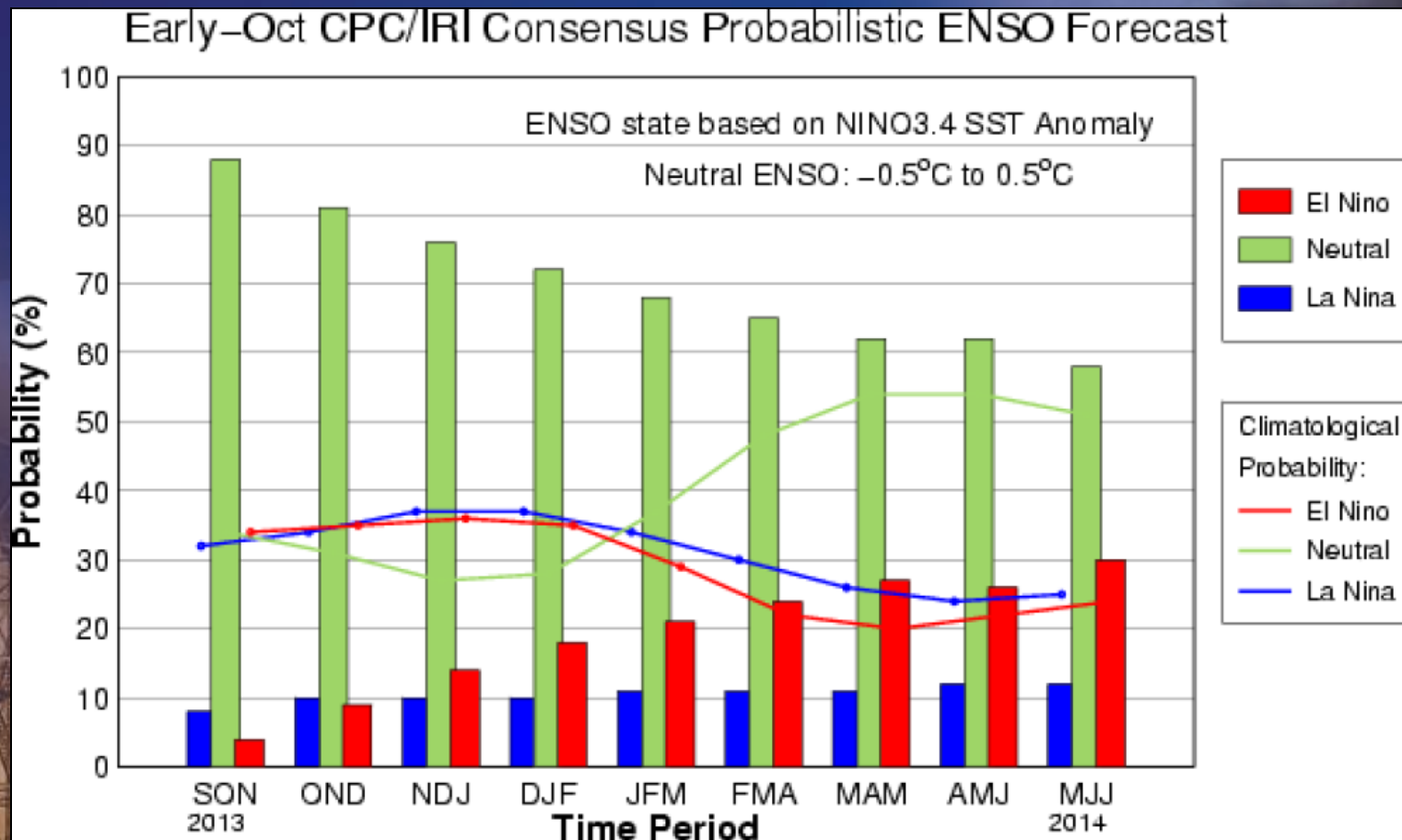


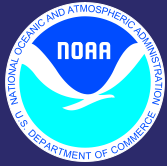
Mid-Oct 2013 Plume of Model ENSO Predictions



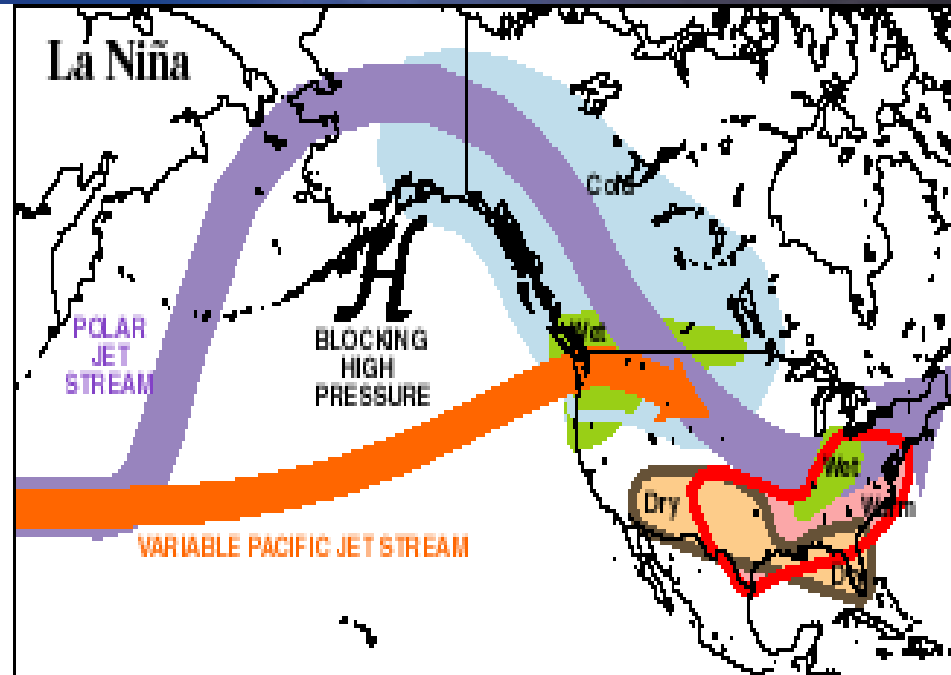
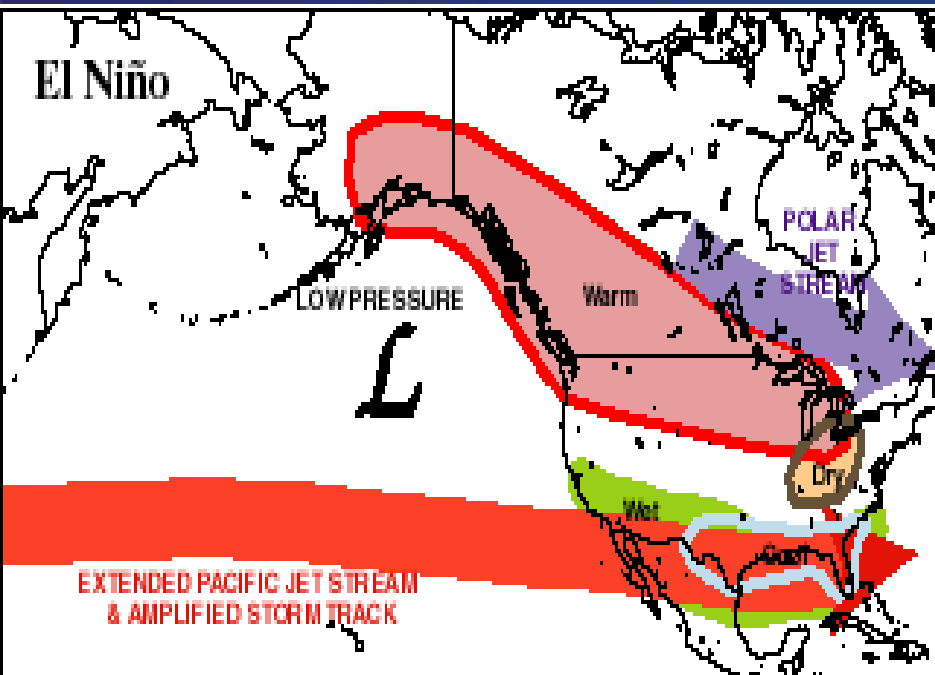


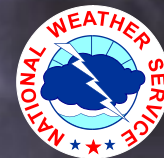
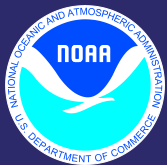

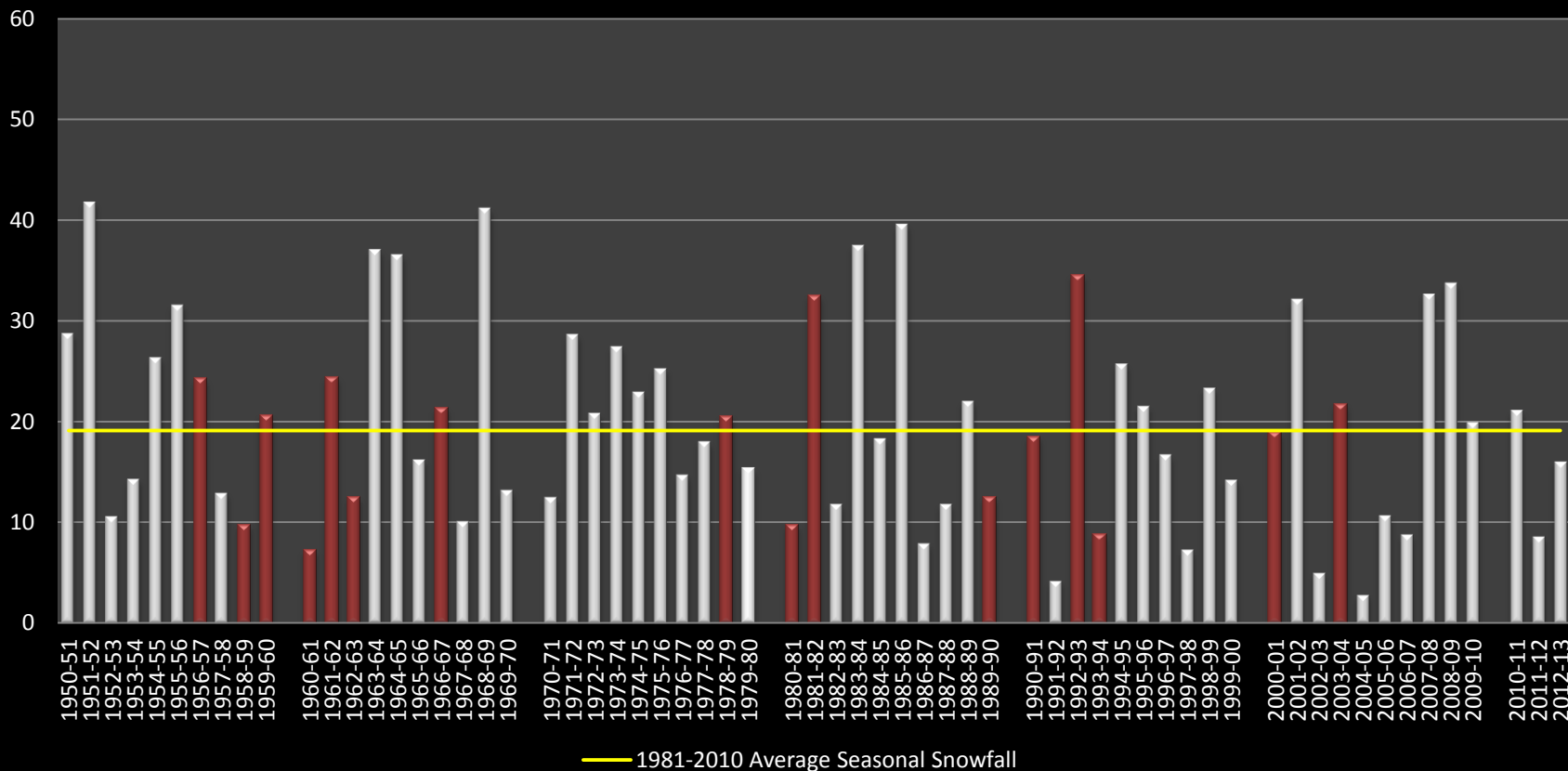
Typical North American Winter Impacts

1950-2013 Snowfall - Neutral ENSO Years (red)

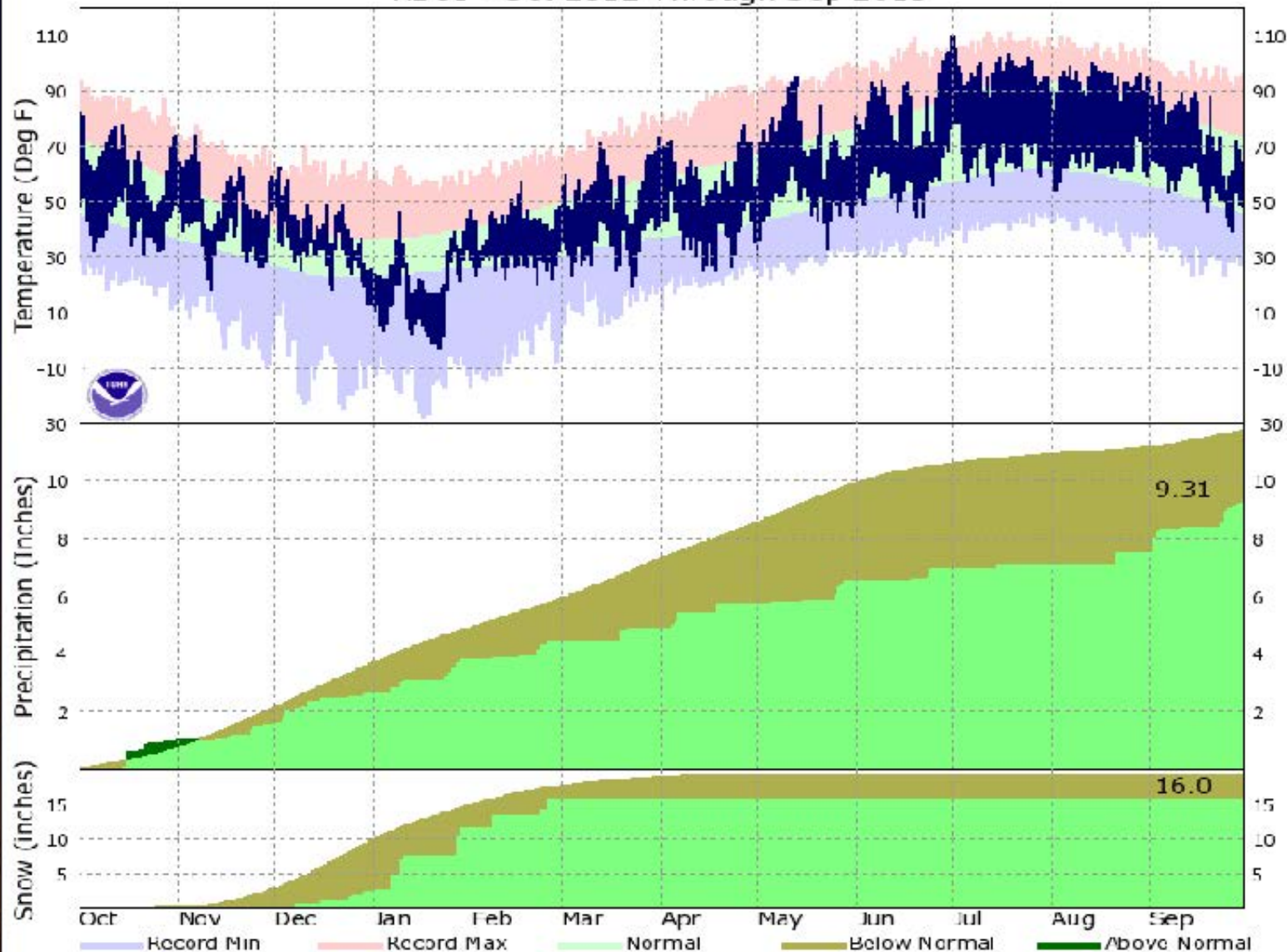




Boise 2013 Water Year



KBOI - Oct 2012 Through Sep 2013

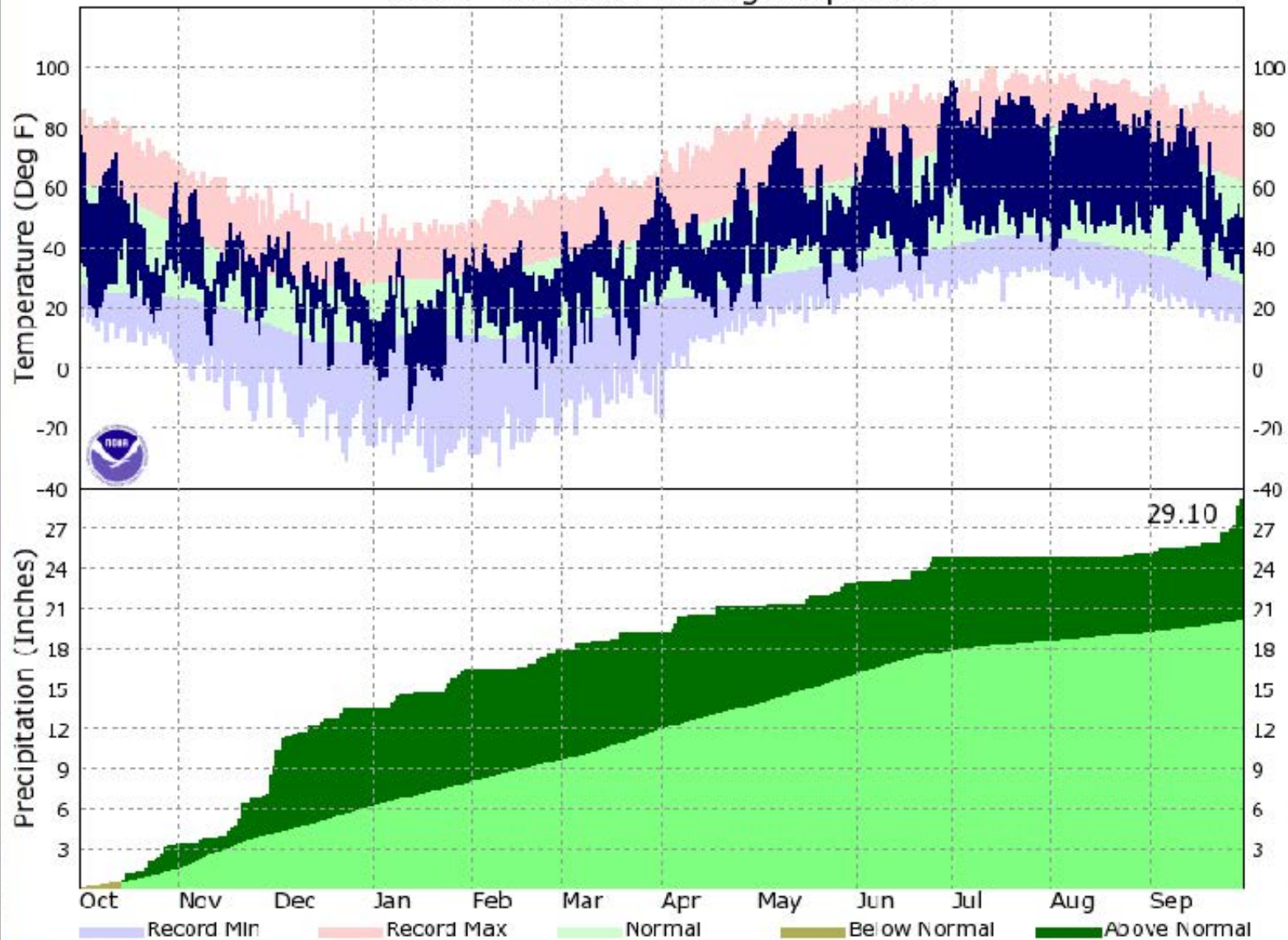




McCall 2013 Water Year

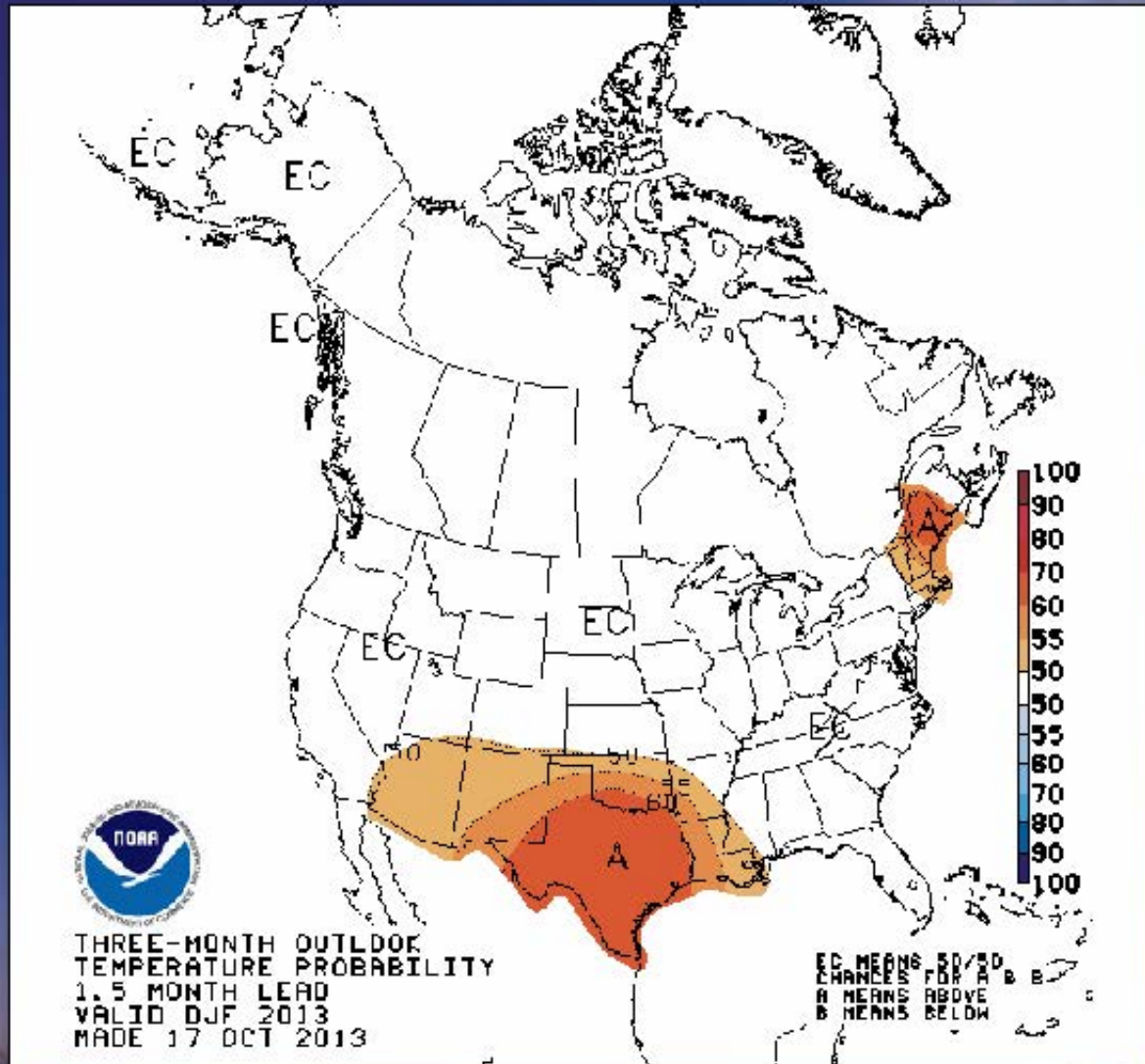


KMYL - Oct 2012 Through Sep 2013



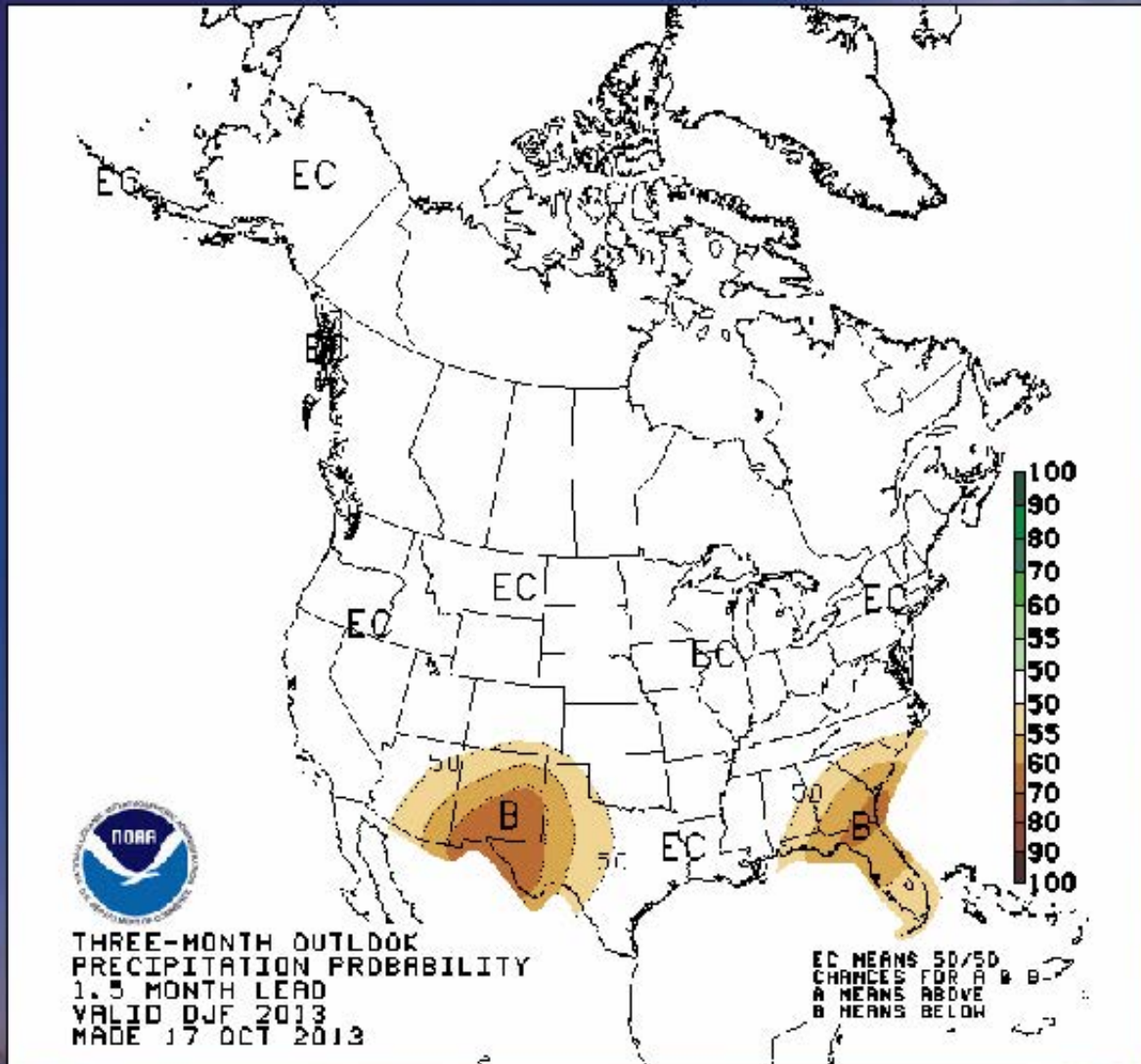


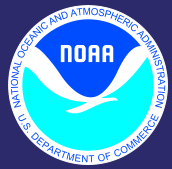
Winter Outlook - Temperature



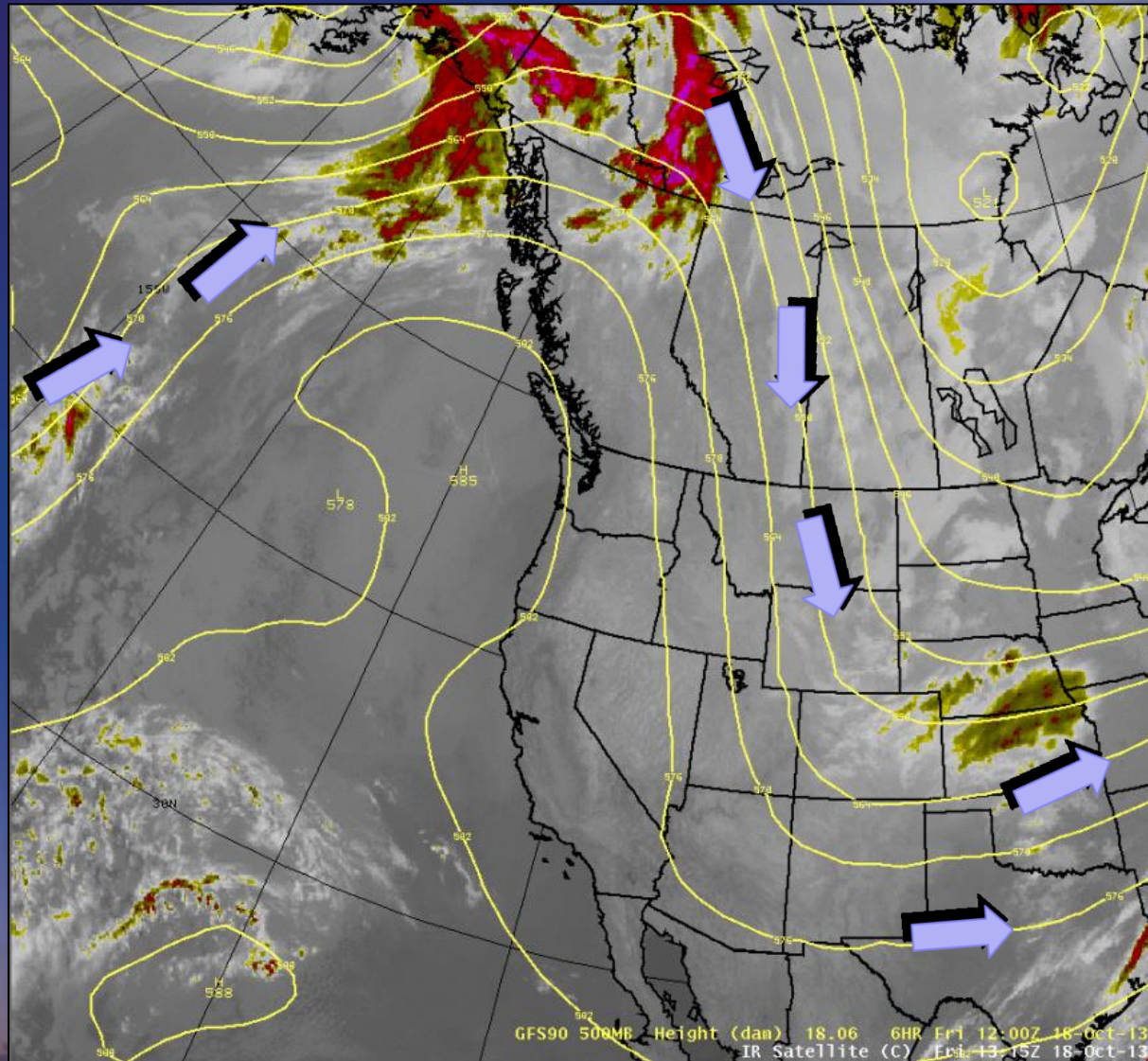


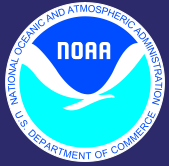
Winter Outlook - Precipitation

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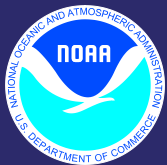

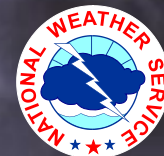
