



Boise Basin Runoff

March 1 – July 31




Boise River Reservoir System Storage (capacity = 249,900 ac-ft)






Anderson Ranch Reservoir Inflows March 1 – July 31



Anderson Ranch Reservoir Storage (capacity = 413,000 ac-ft)






Payette River Runoff at Horseshoe Bend March 1 – July 31




Deadwood Reservoir Inflows March 1 – July 31






Deadwood Reservoir Elevation (spillway elevation = 5334')







Cascade Reservoir Inflows March 1 – July 31




Cascade Reservoir Storage (capacity = 646,600 ac-ft)



Payette River Runoff at Horseshoe Bend March 1 – July 31









Owyhee Reservoir Inflows

March 1 – June 30





Actions planned for 2015 irrigation season

- Start Snake River pumped diversions early
- Delay start of water deliveries from Owyhee Reservoir (?)
- Reduced allotments for Owyhee River water –
 1 to 2 ac-ft /acre
- No Owyhee River deliveries for lands with Snake
 & Owyhee River rights
- Permit water transfers within the districts
